Murrow Indian Children's Home in Muskogee, Oklahoma is an American Baptist ministry that provides a safe, nurturing environment, spiritual foundation, and cultural experience to Native American children in crisis. Murrow provides a home for about 25 children that are in State or Tribal Custody and in the current foster care and adoption system.

Our work during the week may include repair projects, yard work, painting, building projects, organizing supplies, etc. We do not yet have a list of needed projects from Murrow but basically we will be there to do whatever needs doing. There may also be opportunities to visit with the kids at Murrow. We will stay on the campus in the Volunteer Cottage.

COST: Registration is \$50. Registration for college students is \$25 and there is no cost for children going with parents. The registration fee will cover most expenses. We will each be responsible for meals en route and maybe a meal while there.

We have some funds budgeted for the trip and will have a fundraiser on February 18, our annual Cook-Off. Money raised at the cook-off will support the trip, so we ask those participating in the trip to be here for the cook-off if you are able.
