
FACTS ABOUT MALE BREAST CANCER

- For every 130 women who contract breast cancer, one man will contract the same disease.
- For every 1.3 women who contract breast cancer, one man will contract prostate cancer and will have an increased risk for breast cancer as well.
- At least 2,000 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer this year in the United States alone, and others will probably go undiagnosed because much of the medical community is unfamiliar with the disease.
- At least 400 men in the United States are likely to die of breast cancer this year.
- Men with prostate cancer are more likely than the average man to contract breast cancer. These men need to be aware that they can get breast cancer so they recognize the symptoms for what they are. (160,000 will contract it this year.)
- Men who never manifest breast cancer can still pass on the gene to their children creating a greater risk that the girls, in particular, will contract breast cancer. This means that male breast cancer is one of the root causes in the epidemic of female breast cancer!
