<u>Time & Place:</u> We meet every Thursday at the Masonic Temple at the corner of 8th Street and "O" Avenue. Lunch and Fellowship starts at 11:30 AM; the meeting is called to order at 12:00 noon and adjourns around 1:00. If you have not been to a luncheon meeting, we invite you to join us as our guest.

Our lunches are catered by Gere-a-Deli. After your first visit the cost is \$15 for a full lunch and beverage. If you do not want a full lunch the cost is \$5 for beverage and dessert. Each week a guest presenter informs us about community, regional, state-wide, or international projects that impact us as members, citizens, and human beings.

<u>Service Project</u>: We operate the **Thrift Shop, 420 O Avenue, Anacortes, WA**, to raise money to support community and children's projects, both local and international. The Shop is also a place to recycle clean, resalable items and for shopping fun, especially for those who value a dollar. Through our Foundation we have donated over \$3 million in donations and are fast approaching the \$4 million mark. Club members are expected to volunteer at least 4 hours/month in the Shop.

<u>Other Kiwanis Projects</u>: We offer our time and talents to community projects throughout the year, such as helping maintain the three Kiwanis Parks in Anacortes, participating in the Fourth of July Parade, or helping with Kids-R-Best Fest. The Club also supports Key Club at the high school, Builders' Club at the middle school, K-Kids at the elementary level, Aktion Club for individuals with special needs, and most recently, Momentia Club for individuals with dementia and their family and care givers.

Nobody does everything, but every Club member helps out as he or she can.

Please return pages 1-3 (and page 4 if your sponsor returns this to you) to the Kiwanis Thrift Shop, 420 O Avenue, Anacortes, WA 98221. Mark the envelope "application." This page, page 5, is yours to keep.

After your background check has been completed, the Membership Chair will submit your application to the Membership Committee and from there, to the Board of Directors. With the board's approval you are now a member of our Club and can participate in all regular Kiwanis activities, such as working in our Thrift Shop. The Membership Chair will notify you via email of your acceptance and the amount of your new member fees and dues.

Yearly dues are \$123, but new member dues are pro-rated for the fiscal year October 1 to September 30. In addition, there is a one-time new member fee of \$95.
