



## Blessings in Abundance

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

As a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you and your entire house to the Father, all of your

family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Blessed be the Lord, because He hears the voice of our supplications! (Ps. 28:6) In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 14:13, 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless you and your house and keep you. (Num. 6:24) The blessing of the Lord be upon you; be blessed in the name of the Lord! (Ps. 129:8) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call on the God of Israel and ask in the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13, 16:23), our rock (Ps. 18:2), that the Lord would bless you and your family indeed, and enlarge your territory, that His hand would be with you and your house, and that He would keep you and your people from evil, that you and yours will not cause pain. (1 Chr. 4:10) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we petition the Lord to bless you and your family with great abundance. (2 Chr. 31:10) Let the blessing of Abraham come upon you and your family in Christ Jesus, that you might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. (Gal. 3:14) May God Almighty bless you and your house and make you and your family fruitful and multiply you and give you the blessing of Abraham, to you and your descendants with you, that you may inherit the land in which you are a stranger. (Gen. 28:3-4, Heb. 6:14) The Lord shall pour water on you and your family and floods on your dry ground; He will pour His Spirit on your descendants, and His blessing on your offspring. (Is. 44:3) For the Lord has commanded the blessing Life forevermore. (Ps. 133:3) Salvation belongs to the Lord, His blessing is upon you and your house and your descendants. (Ps. 3:8) You shall receive blessing from the Lord, and righteousness from the God of your salvation. (Ps. 24:5) May the Lord God make a hedge around you and your family, around your household, and around all that you have on every side. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord to bless the work of your hands, and make your possessions increase in the land (Job 1:10), according to His word (Ps. 119:58). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God would send now prosperity (Ps. 118:25), and bless your provision (Ps. 132:15); let you and your house prosper, and continue to prosper until you become very prosperous and increase your possessions (Gen. 26:13). May the blessing of the Lord be on all that you have in the house and in the field. (Gen. 39:5) The Lord bless your latter days more than your beginning. (Job 42:12) For the Lord has chosen you and your family as His own inheritance. (Ps. 33:12). Bless the Lord, all His works, in all places of His dominion. Let us bless the Lord with all our souls! (Ps. 103:22)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), our Glory (Jer. 2:11), according to His loving kindness; according to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 51:1) may the Lord your God remember you and your family with the favor He has toward His people; Oh, let Him visit you and your house with His salvation, that you and your family may see the benefit of His chosen ones, that you may rejoice in the gladness of His nation, that you may glory with His inheritance (Ps. 106:4-5). May the Lord fashion your hearts individually; and consider all your works. (Ps. 33:15) Let Him give you and your family obedient hearts that you and your people will diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God that the Lord your God will set you and your house high above all nations on earth and all these blessings shall come upon you and yours and overtake you. Blessed shall you and your family be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country. Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your livestock. Blessed shall be your basket (provision) and your kneading bowl (creativity). Blessed you will be when you come in and blessed you will be when you go out. The Lord will cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you and your house seven ways. The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses (bank accounts) and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving to you. The Lord will establish you and yours as a holy people to Himself. All peoples of the earth shall see that you and your house are called by the name of the Lord. The Lord will grant you and your family plenty of goods, in the fruit of your bodies, in the increase of your livestock, in the produce of your ground. The Lord will open to you and your house the good treasure, the heavens to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hands. You and your people shall lend to many, but you shall not borrow. To a foreigner you may charge interest, but to your brother you shall not charge interest (Deut. 23:20); that the Lord your God may bless you and your family in all to which you set your hands in the land which you are entering to possess (Deut. 23:20). You shall be ever merciful, and lend; and your descendants will be blessed. (Ps. 37:26). The Lord will make you and your house the head and not the tail, you shall be above and not beneath. (Deut. 28:1-13) May you and your family be satisfied with favor, and full of the blessing of the Lord. (Deut. 33:23) May it please the Lord to bless the house of His servant (your house) that it may continue forever before

Him and with His blessing let your house be blessed forever. (2 Sam. 7:29) May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children. May you be blessed by the Lord who made heaven and earth. (Ps. 115:14-15) Blessed be God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth! (Gen. 14:19)

In the name of ***Jesus Christ*** (John 14:13, 16:23), He Himself is your peace (Eph. 2:14), may God choose you and your family and cause you to approach Him, that you may dwell in His courts. That you and your people will be satisfied with the goodness of His house, of His holy temple (Ps. 65:4) and let you and yours be continually in the temple praising God (Luke 24:53), being in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of ***Christ*** (Rom. 15:29), being in communion of the blood of ***Christ*** and communion of the body of ***Christ*** (1 Cor. 10:16), entering into the covenant of ***Christ*** (Heb. 7:22). In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your family will enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations. (Ps. 100:4-5) The Lord is your strength and He is your saving refuge for you and yours are His anointed. The Lord is your hiding place; He shall preserve you and your family from trouble; He shall surround you and your house with songs of deliverance (Ps. 32:7); with favor He will surround you and your people as with a shield (Ps. 5:12). According to the integrity (Ps. 78:72) of His heart (Jer. 3:15) let the Lord save you and your family and bless His inheritance; shepherd you and your people also and bear you and your family up forever (Ps. 28:8-9). In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord to instruct you and your people and teach you in the way you should go, He will guide you and your family with His eye (Ps. 32:8) and give you rest from the days of adversity (Ps. 94:13). You and your family shall seek the Lord and He will hear you and deliver you from all your fears (Ps. 34:4). The Lord will bless you and your house with peace. (Ps. 29:11) And may your descendants possess the gates of those who hate them. (Gen. 24:60) Blessed be the Lord who has pleaded the cause of your reproach and kept you and your house from evil. (1 Sam. 25:39)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord ***Jesus Christ***, who has blessed you and your family with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in ***Christ***. (Eph. 1:3) He will bless you and your house and make your name great; and you and your family shall be a blessing. (Gen. 12:2) You and your

house shall dwell in the safety of God, Who shelters you all the day long; and you and your house shall dwell between His shoulders. Your land shall be blessed, with the precious things of heaven, with the dew, and the deep lying beneath, with the precious fruits of the sun, with the precious produce of the months, with the best things of the ancient mountains, with the precious things of the everlasting hills, with the precious things of the earth and its fullness, and the favor of God. In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13, 16:23), your surety of a better covenant (Heb. 7:22), let the blessing come on your heads (Deut. 33:12-16). And let your paths drip with abundance. (Ps. 65:11) For the Lord God is a sun and shield. The Lord will give grace and glory to you and your family. No good thing will He withhold from you and your people who walk uprightly. (Ps. 84:11) Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing! (Rev. 5:12)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13, 16:23), all nations shall call Him blessed (Ps 72:17), in Jesus' name let you and your family dip your foot in the oil (Deut. 33:24); so that you will serve the Lord your God (Ex. 23:25), with fear, rejoicing with trembling, willingly offering yourselves (Neh. 11:2). May the Lord separate you and your people to stand before the Lord and minister to Him and to bless in His Name. (Deut. 10:8) He will bless your bread and your water. (Ex. 23:25) The Lord will bless your habitation. (Prov. 3:33) The Lord will take away from you and your people all sickness (Ex. 23:25, Deut. 7:15) and fulfill the number of your days (Ex. 23:26). The Lord will send His fear before you and your house and cause confusion among all your enemies, He will send hornets before you and your family, which shall drive out your enemies before you (Ex. 23:27-28), little by little (Deut. 7:22). The arms of your hands are made strong by the hands of the Shepherd, the stone of Israel, the Mighty God of Jacob, who will help you and your people, and by the Almighty who will bless you and your house with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lies beneath, blessings of the breasts and of the womb. (Gen. 49:24-26) The Lord will give you and your people counsel; and instruct your hearts in the night seasons. (Ps.

16:7) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will hear the instruction of God's wisdom and be wise, watching daily at its gates, waiting at the posts of its doors. That you and your people find wisdom and find life and obtain favor from the Lord. (Prov. 8:33-35) Because the Lord is at your right hand you and your family shall not be moved. Your hearts shall be glad and

your flesh will rest in hope. For the Lord will show you and your people the path of life. In His presence is fullness of joy; at His right hand are pleasures forevermore. (Ps. 16:7-11) Your delight will be in the word of God (Ps. 1:2) for the Lord loves you and your house, you and your family are in His hand, you shall sit down at His feet and receive His words (Deut. 33:3). According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in Christ Jesus before time began (2 Tim. 1:9) may the Lord bless your substance and accept the work of your hands (Deut. 33:11). Let you and your family be like a tree planted by the rivers of water that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaves also shall not wither; and whatever you and your people do shall prosper. (Ps. 1:3) Blessed be the Lord God who has not forsaken His mercy and His truth! (Gen. 24:27)

In the name of Jesus Christ, for of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever (Rom. 11:36); in His precious name may the Lord your God be with you and your family, that He may incline your hearts to Himself, to walk in all His ways (1 Kin. 8:57-58), that you and your family will keep justice and will do righteousness at all times (Ps. 106:3), that God shall cause showers to come down in your season; there shall be showers of blessing (Ezek. 34:26) on your righteous heads (Prov. 10:6). You and your people shall rebuke the wicked and have delight, and a good blessing will come upon you. (Prov. 24:25) Blessed are you and your family to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile. (Ps. 32:2) According to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:7) let the Lord bless you and your family with prudence and understanding (2 Chr. 2:12) and may you and your people wait on the Lord (Is. 30:18). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will fear the Lord and walk in His ways. (Ps. 128:1) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will know the joyful sound and walk in the light of God's countenance (Ps. 89:15), that you and yours will seek Him with all your whole heart (Ps. 119:2). Let you and your family walk in your integrity that your children may be blessed after you. (Prov. 20:7) The Lord lives! Blessed be your Rock! Let the God of your salvation be exalted! (Ps. 18:46)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13, 16:23), He who is appointed heir of all things (Heb. 1:2), in His name we ask that God grant you and your family to have bountiful eyes (Prov. 22:9) and generous souls (Prov. 11:25), that you shall be faithful (Prov. 28:20) and sow beside all waters (Is. 32:20). May you and your people

sow in the land and reap in the same year a hundred fold. (Gen. 6:12) In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will give as you are able, according to the blessing of the Lord your God which He has given to you and your house (Deut. 16:17) and your hearts shall not be grieved when you give (Deut. 15:10). Let you and your family give the best of all your first fruits of any kind to the Lord. (Ezek. 44:30) Let you and your people bring all your tithes into the storehouse of the Kingdom of God (Mal. 3:10) and lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven (Matt. 6:20). Let you and yours water so you will also be watered. (Prov. 11:25-26) May the Lord open for you and your family the windows of heaven and pour out for you and your house such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. (Mal. 3:10) May the blessing of the Lord make you and your people rich and may He add no sorrow with it. (Prov. 10:22) Wealth and riches will be in your house, and your righteousness shall endure forever. Unto you and your house arise light in the darkness and let you and yours be gracious, full of compassion, righteous. May you and your people deal graciously and lend and guide your affairs with discretion. Surely you and your house will never be shaken. You and your house will be in everlasting remembrance. (Ps. 112:3-6) Bless the Lord. O Lord, our God, You are very great: You are clothed with honor and majesty, Who covers Himself with light as with a garment, Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain. (Ps. 104:1-2)

In the name of ***Jesus Christ*** (John 14:13, 16:23), the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 46:18), trust in the name of the Lord (Zeph. 3:12) and you and your family will not be afraid of evil tidings for surely your hearts shall be steadfast (Ps. 57:7), trusting in the Lord (Ps. 2:12). Your hearts are established. (Ps. 112:8) You and your house shall not return evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you and your people are called to this, that you and your family may inherit a blessing. (1 Pet. 3:9) Out of your mouths you and your people shall speak blessing and not cursing (James 3:10) and the Lord bless you and your house in all things (Gen.24:1). May God give you and your house of the dew of heaven, of the fatness of the earth, and plenty of grain and wine. (Gen. 27:28) Let you and your family rejoice in all to which you put your hands, you and your household, in which the Lord your God has blessed. (Deut. 12:7) When you have eaten and you are full, then you and your house shall bless the Lord our God for the good which He has given to

you. (Deut. 8:10) Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever. (Rev. 5:13)

In the name of ***Jesus Christ*** (John 14:13, 16:23), through His name you will trample those who rise up against you (Ps. 44:5), for the Lord shall bless those who bless you and your family and curse those who curse you and your family (Gen. 12:2-3). The blessing of the Lord be upon you and your house. (Ps. 129:8) May the Lord your God turn every curse into a blessing for you and your people, because the Lord your God loves you. (Deut. 23:5-6) Let the enemy curse, but God bless you and your house. When your enemy arises, let them be ashamed, but let God's servants, you and your family, rejoice. Let your accusers be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own disgrace as with a mantle. (Ps. 109:28-29) Your enemies shall submit to you and your house, and you shall tread down their high places. (Deut. 33:29) God gives you and your people strength and power. (Ps. 68:35) Blessed is your house whose strength is in God Most High (Ps. 84:5) for you and yours go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7). Your sandals shall be iron and bronze; as your days, so shall your strength be. (Deut. 33:25) May the Lord meet you and your family with the blessing of goodness (Ps. 21:3) and look down from His holy habitation, from heaven, and bless you and your family and the land He has given you (Deut. 26:15). For the Lord, has made you and your house most blessed forever. (Ps. 21:6) Blessed be God Most High who has delivered your enemies into your hand! (Gen. 14:20)

The Lord has made you and your family exceedingly glad with His presence. (Ps. 21:6) And through the mercy of the Most High you and your people shall not be moved. (Ps. 21:7) In the name of ***Jesus Christ*** (John 14:13, 16:23), the Son of the Highest (Luke 1:32), the Lord bless you and your family and keep you. The Lord make His face shine upon you and your house, and be gracious to you. The Lord lift up His countenance upon you and your people, and give you peace. The Lord put His name on you and your children and bless you and your house. (Num. 6:24-27) And may you and your family bless the Lord with all your souls and all that is within you, bless His holy name! And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your lives from destruction, Who crowns you and your people with loving kindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your

mouths with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. The Lord executes righteousness and justice for you and your house. (Ps. 103:1-6) Blessed be the Lord who has given rest to you and your family according to all that he has promised. There has not failed one word of all His good promise. (1 Kin. 8:56) Blessing and glory and wisdom, thanksgiving and honor and power and might, be to our God forever and ever. (Rev. 7:12)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), ***Jesus Christ***, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in ***Christ***, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that ***Christ*** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord ***Jesus Christ***. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and ***Christ*** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). We ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9), for it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it. You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) We will extol You, our God, O King; and we will bless Your name forever and ever. Every day we will bless You, and we will praise Your name forever and ever. (Ps. 145:1-2) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
