



Kenneth B. Colquette

The Marion County Board of Education recently approved a resolution to name the football field at Marion County High School (MCHS) "Ken Colquette Field".

Colquette was the head football coach of the Marion County Warriors for 17 years starting in 1980. He led the Warriors to four state championships in 1990, 1992, 1994 and 1995, and two state runners-up titles. He was inducted into the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association in 2014.

"Coach Colquette's football accomplishments and his state championships here at Marion County speak for themselves," said current Warrior head football coach Joey Mathis. "He and his team's accomplishments put Marion football on the map and made them

permanent fixtures in the playoffs during his time here. It's a great honor for any coach and I'm sure he's very appreciative of the field dedication."

Colquette has an overall record of 257-94. He began his coaching career in the states of South Carolina and Georgia, and he came to Tennessee in 1976 as the offensive coordinator for Cleveland.

After he resigned from Marion County in 1996, Colquette coached in Georgia. He returned to his alma mater Grundy County in 2001 where he was the principal and athletic director for eight years. He also coached there for four years.

He retired from education in 2008 but took over the head coaching spot at Sequatchie County that year. He resigned from there in 2014.
