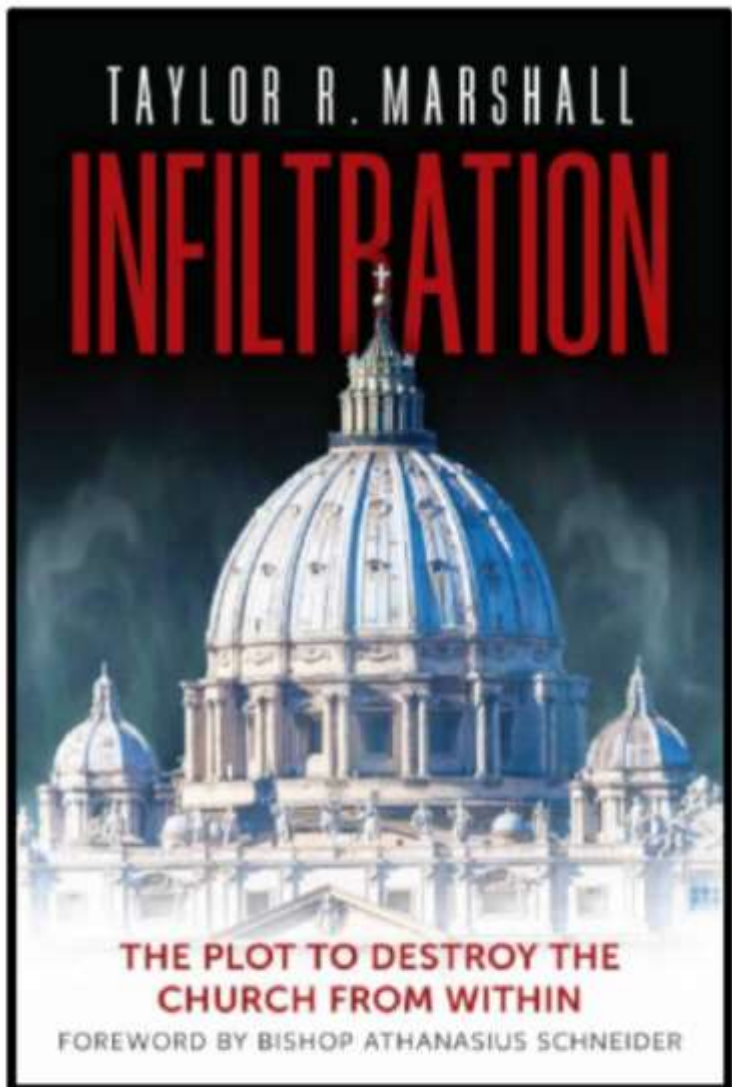
Infiltration by Dr. Taylor Marshall
