Holy Week is Here!

Holy Week is my favorite week of the Liturgical Year so let me tell you just what you can experience this week:

<u>Palm Sunday (April 14th)-</u> We attend Mass and recall Jesus entering Jerusalem on a donkey with the people waving palms shouting "Hosanna!" Then things change for the Gospel when we proclaim the Passion (suffering) and death of Christ and people are now shouting for Christ to be crucified... At 3pm the same day we will have a Penance Service at Sacred Heart with priests from around the deanery who can hear your confessions.

(April 16th)- Chrism Mass- This Mass takes place at the cathedral in Toledo. The Holy Oils are blessed by the bishop and then people from all over the diocese take them back to their parishes. The priests of the diocese renew the promises they made at their ordination as well. This takes place at 11am and lasts about 2 hours. It is a beautiful Mass that I love to attend. Perhaps you can attend as well.

Wednesday (April 17)- Bible Study- Yes Bible Study returns after a March hiatus. It is at it's usual time of 7 p.m. in the convocation center. We will also meet the next Wednesday (April 24) to make up for missing our March class. Let us continue to be enlightened studying the Gospel of John!

<u>Holy Thursday Mass (April 18th)-</u> This marks the official end of Lent and the beginning of the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil). At this Mass, we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper and the priest imitates Christ by washing the feet of parishioners. We will also have a procession with the Eucharist and end with adoration. This Mass will take place at Sacred Heart at 6:30pm.

<u>Good Friday- April 19th – This marks one of only two days that the Catholic Church does not celebrate Mass (Holy Saturday morning is the other day). We will have the full Service at 3pm at Sacred Heart (reading of the Passion, Veneration of the Cross, Communion). St. Joseph will have Stations of the Cross and Veneration of the Cross at 7pm. Christ's sacrifice for our salvation is something always to be treasured. Someone else I also treasure- my mom- will be celebrating her birthday this day. My mom helped me to treasure Jesus Christ in my life. Thank you, mom, and have a Happy Birthday in the love of Christ!</u>

Easter Vigil Mass (April 20^h)- This is the Mass when people come into full communion with The Catholic Church. Cierra Roberts, Amanda Crafton, Stephanie Schlitz and Lindsey Mills will be coming into our faith this year! This Mass will be at Sacred Heart and begin at 8:30 p.m. This is also what I believe to be the most beautiful and wonderful Mass the Catholic Church celebrates all year. Yes, it is long, but I believe every Catholic should attend this Mass at least once in their life so maybe this is you year to attend.

MINUTES Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish Finance Council March 26, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Moderator C. Vogt and opened with prayer by Fr. Bohnsack.

Motion carried to approve the minutes as modified from the January 29, 2019 meeting (C. Vogt/T. Jessee).

Pastor's Report - Nothing to report

Principal's Report - Nothing to report

Business Manger's Report

- Comparative Balance Sheet as of February 28, 2019 Assets total \$692,985. This is lower by \$14,700 compared to June 30, 2018. This is due to funds taken from savings to cover the Parish Hall addition which have not been replenished to date. A total of \$576,590 is currently on deposit with the Diocese.
- January and February Income Statement/Budget and Comparisons Year-to-date is showing a loss of \$20,288 through the end of February. This is better than budgeted by \$63,794. All bills and assessments are paid in full as of February 2019.
- After discussion, motion carried to approve the financial statements (J. Finnegan/L. Rietschlin).

Old Business

- J. Palm attended the Finance Council training in Ottoville. She found it very helpful and was comfortable that this council is in compliance with Diocese guidelines.
- No action taken on the front doors of the church.
- Altar & Rosary continue work on replacing carpet in church. It was also suggested to consider replacing the linoleum in the boy's sacristy.

New Business

- C. Gosser presented an estimate from Central Ohio Plumbing and Heating for labor and materials to replace drain lines and flush valves for the restrooms in the school building. Since the water would have to be turned off, the work would be completed this summer. It was the consensus of the group that these repairs are long overdue. *Motion carried to approve the estimate and move forward with the project* (R. Cole/J. Finnegan). These charges will be paid by the Shelby Settlers.
- J. Palm will be working on next fiscal year's budget. Deadline is May 1, she will ask for an extension since the next meeting of this Finance Council is late May.

Next meeting: May 21, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. after Mass at the Parish Center.

Meeting adjourned and closed with a prayer.
