These are the programs that allow us to have a non-profit status. Each of these impact our communities, Veterans, active duty and their families. If you are interested in becoming involved in any of these worthy programs, please give the chairman a call and offer your ideas and time. The hospital program can always use volunteers for chapel hour, coffee admissions, donations of good used clothing and household items. Volunteers for patriotic programs in our schools, handing out certificates to residents and businesses that fly their flags helps our Americanism program. Stay involved with the legislative issues impacting our Veterans, make your voice heard.

Patriot's Pen and Voice of Democracy

This is a brief look at two of the scholarship programs for youth sponsored by the VFW. Each program encourages writing skills in middle school and high school students. Competition is held first at the Post; that winner then competes against the

winners of the other Posts in our District; the District winners then compete to represent the Department of Colorado in the national competition.

Patriot's Pen is an essay-writing contest held each year across the United States for students in any school (public, private, home-schooled) in grades 6, 7, and 8. The program is designed to foster patriotism. Each contestant submits a 300-400 word, typed essay on the annual theme. This year's theme is "America's Gift to My Generation". The deadline for submission of the entry form is October 31. The national first place winner receives a \$5,000 savings bond and an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. A total of 54 national prizes are awarded. The entry form is online at <u>www.vfw.org</u>: click on "Community", then "Youth & Education"; then "Patriot's Pen"; scroll down to the link to the entry form and competition rules.

The **Voice of Democracy** scholarship program is an audio-essay contest for high school students in grades 9-12. Each contestant submits an original, typed essay between 3-5 minutes along with a CD recorded in the student's voice reading his/her essay. The national first place winner receives a \$30,000 college scholarship. The deadline for submission of the entry form is October 31. This year the theme is "American History: Our Hope for the Future." The entry form is online at <u>www.vfw.org</u>: click on "Community"; then "Youth & Education; then on "VOD"; scroll down to the link to its entry form and rules.

The state winners of each competition receive an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. in March 2018.

Please encourage any student in our area in grades 6-8 (Patriot's Pen) and grades 9-12 (Voice of Democracy) to submit an entry; entries can be dropped off at Post 7945 or at my home, 11913 Quam Drive, Northglenn, Colorado.

If you have any questions concerning any of these programs, please feel free to **contact me at 303-452-0474.** Remember entries for Patriot's Pen and Voice of Democracy must be in my possession no later than October 31, 2017.
