Changes to our 2017 Horse Show Program:

Ring 2 – deleted several classes that we had zero entries to maybe 1 or 2 entries in last year. SR Showmanship went away but we added OPEN class Showmanship so if we have SRs come to show, they can enter open class but if we don't have any SR's, this open class will provide Novice, YO and JR exhibitors another showmanship class to enter. With only one entry in both Wes Nov Horse and Wes Nov Rider W/J classes, we deleted 2 of the 4 classes but made each of the remaining 2 class their very own Year-End Division. We did the same thing for both Wes YO ad Wes Jr/Sr Walk-Jog classes with making Horsemanship its own division and Pleasure its own division. We dropped the Programmed Ride class in both of these divisions.

Most all of the WJL classes/year-end divisions are now OPEN classes due to the lack of YO/JR/SR riders to have separate classes.

We added 2 new Divisions to Ring 2: Therapeutic Riding and Arab/Morgan Hunter Pleasure

Ring 1 – We dropped the “schooling” classes – entries decreasing every year since we first offered. We dropped Eng Open Disciplined Rail class. English Senior WTC classes were on the chopping block but we decided to offer one more show season.

BIG CHANGE to Eng Youth W/T and Eng JR W/T Divisions: YO W/T classes are now each a Year-End Division. Eng JR Rider, we now have Equitation W/T as a division and then the other performance type classes as their own separate division. Please check our Circuit Division Information page for specifics so you will know how to complete the CM form.

Eng YO WTC – for now we have 3 divisions: Equitation, Hunter Hack and then the 3 Performance classes make up one div. Last year we split the 3 Perf classes into separate divisions and we may do that again if Eng YO WTC participation is good. Just means that our YO riders will have to pay additional CM fees for 2 more Year-End Divisions if we split.

We added 2 new classes to the English ring, both Over Fences. However by adding we didn't change the number of total classes since we dropped a few classes from this ring. The 2 new classes are for those riders just beginning to jump. Both classes have jumps set at just 12 inches. Hunter Hack Beginner W/T has 2 cross rails at 12" and Equitation O/F W/T has 4 vertical fences set at 12". If riders choose to participate in these classes, they are NOT allowed to enter any other over fences classes EXCEPT Open Hunter Hack W/T at 18".

We will monitor the turnout of Youth Riders for the 2017 season in our English Youth Rider W/T Division. Last year we ended up with 22 riders so we split in 2 age groups and ran 6 classes vs. just 3. We will decide at the May show whether to split again based on turnout.

Ring 3 Trail – No classes were added nor dropped from ring 3 for the 2017 season. However we did decide to shutdown ring 3 half-hour earlier so our judge who is paid by the hour is not billing the club for overtime hours after the agreed time of 5 hours. Hopefully we will then have Trail Class results 30 minutes earlier so we can begin announcing the placings.
