Celebrating our fifth anniversary on the air and streaming on Sunday, September 13th, KTWH invites everyone to show your support for community radio in Two Harbors. Listen in between 1 and 5 pm this Sunday the 13th for live phone visits with volunteer programmers and soundbite blasts from the past 5 years of community radio for Greater Two Harbors and listeners across the globe. Hosts Michelle and Leo will dish up music, lively stories and good conversation about our radio journey -leave the game on with the sound down and check it out at 99.5 FM, or listen online at ktwh.org.

KTWH went on air and streaming live on Sunday, September 13, 2015 as Lake County's first on-the-ground FM radio service. KTWH has provided area listeners with weather, shipping news, community events, emergency alerts and critical response information, as well as stories and insights from a wide array of citizens as well as representatives of government, schools, businesses and social agencies that serve our area. KTWH is a volunteer-driven, listener supported grassroots medium dedicated to providing news that only a local outlet has the focus and commitment to bring to residents.

The station has adapted its operations during the COVID-19 pandemic in order to provide regular updates on many aspects of our local, national, and global responses to the virus. The economic downturn locally led the station to suspend fundraising this year until the week of September 14-19th. KTWH will feature special programming during the drive and asks listeners to consider any financial support they can offer to this nonprofit radio service. KTWH will offer highlights of the past five years as well as sharing new music from a number of local musicians during the fund drive week.
