Since the weather seems to be remaining hot and humid, please remember that greyhounds are INDOOR dogs and should stay inside with air conditioning when the temperatures rise. Greyhounds can overheat easily. Please remember to take early morning and late

evening walks. Watch for signs of overheating.

- Panting, followed by disorientation and fast, noisy breathing
- Collapsing or convulsing
- Bright red or blue gums or tongue
- Vomiting and diarrhea

If your greyhound is exhibiting any of these signs, take him or her to your vet immediately!



## MCGA Prison Program



Our Prison Program began August 2015, when we placed several greyhounds into the Metro-Davidson County Detention Facility, located in Davidson County, Nashville, Tennessee. The greyhounds live in the facility and their assigned dog handlers care for them, including feeding, exercise, grooming, companionship and training. Dana Mead is our dog trainer working with the handlers and dogs each week. This program benefits both the dogs and their handlers and lasts ten weeks. Afterwards, the dogs move into foster homes and are available for adoption.
