Christian Family and Marriage

Christian Families are Built With...

- Wisdom
- Understanding
- Knowledge.

By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established; through knowledge its rooms are filled with rare and beautiful treasures. *Proverbs 24:3-4*

Christian Families are Built With...

- Wisdom is the ability to see with discernment, to view life as God perceives it
- Understanding is the skill to respond with insight
- Knowledge is the rare trait of learning with perception-discovering and growing

- And are able to solve problems in a crisis



What is the purpose of marriage and family? Companionship and commitment

- It is not good for the man to be alone (Genesis 2:18)
- God's answer to man's need was to create woman
- Marriage was God's answer for humankind's deepest human need

Marriage and Family: A Divine Design

Where Does Family Begin?

- Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth... (Genesis 1:28)
- That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh. Adam and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame (Genesis 2:24-25)

Marriage and Family: Biblical Guidelines

1-severance: "leave his father and mother"2-permanence: "cleave to his wife"3-unit: "they shall become one flesh"4-intimacy: "both naked and were not ashamed"

Marriage: Biblical View

- Marriage is a heterosexual covenant between one man and one woman consummated in total union for companionship and procreation often sealed by a public ceremony for a lifelong relationship
- Exclusive, heterosexual, covenant, between one man and one woman, ordained and sealed by God, often preceded by a public leaving of parents, consummated in sexual union.
- Marriage is the total union of husband and wife on the intellectual, social, spiritual, emotional and physical levels

Finding God in Marriage and Family: Deuteronomy 6:1-13

Hear the truth continually (v. 4)
Love the Lord fervently (v.5)
Teach the Young Diligently (v.7)
Fear the Lord Greatly (v.10)

Marriage: Biblical View

- God is so thoroughly involved in marriage that whenever anything different than He has suggested or taught is done, disaster is on its way.
- True freedom is when we live for the purpose God created us.
- A good marriage is when a man and woman fulfill their duties and live 'rightly' under the proper restraints.

Theology of marriage and Family

- God created marriage as a loyal partnership between one man and one woman.
- Marriage is the firmest foundation for building a family.
- God designed sexual expression to help married couples build intimacy.
- Marriage mirrors God's covenant relationship with His people.

Emerging Family Trends

Emerging Family Trends (1960-2010)



 Decline in Marriage rates: 50 percent
 Increased Divorce rate: 40 to 50%
 Increased 'unmarried' Cohabitation: 10 fold
 Reduction in Size of Family: 4 to 2 children
 Increased Dysfunctional families – 9% to 28%
 Changing attitudes about sex, marriage and familyalternatives to marriage, unwed childbearing (35%), abortion, homosexuality, extramarital relationship, and virtual pleasure – All on an upswing



35% Chosen by self – 'Love' Marriage






34% Arranged by parents – 'Arranged' Marriage

7% Other



Marriage is a lifelong commitment Biblical position of Husband and Wife Living Together Prior to Marriage is NOT acceptable Premarital counseling is essential People should marry a person from the same... Courtship is acceptable Alcoholic beverages are NOT permissible at the... Modesty should be the hallmark of the wedding... Interfaith marriage is NOT acceptable Divorce should be permitted only in rare cases Dating is NOT Biblical Dating is NOT acceptable

(Matthew 7:24-29)






