



This month is all about Green Buildings with a focus on State of the Art HVAC Systems and Products.

It all happens on Nov 20 at Marshall University's new Engineering Building in Huntington. What a showcase building.

The new \$56 million Arthur Weisberg Family Applied Engineering Complex houses MU's College of Information Technology and Engineering, along with other research, science and math facilities. It has high-tech classrooms, labs, offices and spaces where students will work on collaborative projects.

ASHRAE events start with a WV ASHRAE Chapter Board Meeting at 10 am. (Look for signs in the building for the meeting room location.) Main topic: Chapter leaders, Marshall Faculty and Students will be discussing starting an ASHRAE Student Branch at Marshall. (The WV ASHRAE Chapter currently has one Student Branch at WVU in

Morgantown.)

The WV ASHRAE Lunch Meeting starts at 11:30 AM. Dennis Stanke, an ASHRAE Fellow and Distinguished Lecturer, will overview the latest ASHRAE 189.1 Green Building Standard. Mr Stanke is a past Chair of the ASHRAE 189.1 Standard Committee and is considered to be an expert on green buildings and IAQ. If you are somewhat confused about the different green and energy standards (ASHRAE 189.1, IGCC, LEED 3.0/4.0, Green Globes, ASHRAE BEQ, Energy Star, etc.) **this is a lunch you need to attend.** Learn about the differences and why the ASHRAE 189.1 Green Building Standard is gaining broader usage.

After lunch will be tour of the new 145,000-square-foot MU Engineering Building lead by the Project Engineer and Project Contractor. Attendees will have the option to view and maybe interact with the building state of the art automation controls system

After the tour, Mr Stanke will have an in depth 2 hour session focused on the HVAC side of the most recent ASHRAE 189.1 Standard.

The lunch and afternoon sessions qualify for PDH credits.
