

Please make sure to sign out anything you want to take home, there is a 2-week limit per item. Also make sure to take good care of the items so that others can enjoy them.




Pastor's Book & Movie of the Month

October is Reformation month when Lutherans prepare to commemorate the Reformation on the Sunday closest to October 31st. This is a great time to revisit and study our Lutheran faith so that by knowing who we are we can reach out to others in faith!

Book of the Month: Martin Luther: A Man Who Changed the World by Paul Maier

A great book to read to get a quick overview of the life of Martin Luther. The Book includes beautiful pictures, and even a map of the important places in Luther's life. Also check out the yellow hand out called Lutheran Confessions to learn more about what beliefs make Lutherans unique, and how Luther helped to write some of them.



Movie of the Month: Martin Luther: The Idea That Changed the World

This 2017 PBS special is the best documentary out there if you want to learn about Martin Luther, his life, his faith, and the beliefs of Lutheranism. It is a longer documentary (around 2 hours) but it will cover subjects Lutherans do not often talk about including Luther's dark writings like *On the Jews and Their Lies* which were used by the



Nazi's, as well as how some of Luther's writings inspired the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. who is named after Martin Luther.
