## Common Q\&A about the WMASS Tournament

- Q: How many teams can qualify?
- A: Depends on the sport but most are top 8
- Q: How do you qualify? How does the seeding work?
- Seeding is Based off the MIAA state power rankings.
- Then we make a W. Mass power ranking based off the state's rankings
- Top 8 (some 4) teams in each Class qualify
- Q: How will ties in the power rankings be decided
- We will be using the MIAA tiebreaker rule

## Common Q\&A about the WMASS Tournament

- Q : When will the tournaments take place?
- A: The tournament has been built into the last week of the regular season.
- Q: Will the Championship game count towards the state ranking?
- A: No, The championship game is considered an MIAA exemption game and will not count towards the state ranking.
- Q: What happens to the teams that get eliminated in the first round?
- A: Tournament Teams that gets eliminated in the first round will get a consolation game that will count towards the state ranking.

- A: Teams that don't qualify will still get to play the last two games because it will count towards state ranking
- Q: How will the games for the teams that didn't qualify for the tournament be scheduled?
