

NOTICE OF RACE



6th ANNUAL Laser “PLANK REGATTA” SATURDAY JUNE 9, 2018

Rules:

I. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

a. Races open to Laser Standard, Radial, and 4.7 rigs

II. Fleets

a. A fleet shall consist of 3 or more boats. If 3 or more boats are not present, fleets may be combined with all contestants starting and finishing together and being scored as one fleet.

b. Races will be held in the Kettle Creek and Upper Barnegat Bay (Green Island Course)

III. 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice of Race except as they may be changed by the sailing instructions .

IV. 2.2 The organizing authority is Shore Acres Yacht Club, Brick, NJ, USA.

V. ENTRANCE FEE: \$25.00 per boat. \$5.00 per boat for those registered to sail in the District 10 Laser Standard Championships on June 9. Preregistration is available on line.

VI. SCHEDULE:

a. 0800-0945 : Check in & Breakfast

b. 1000 : Skippers' Meeting

c. 1030: First Warning Signal

d. 1030 – 1630: Racing (Snacks/Water/Beverages Available On Water)

e. 1630-1700: Awards & Light Snacks

f. RACES:

i. There will be 5 planned races, weather permitting. One race constitutes a regatta.

VII. SCORING:

a. The low point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. If 4 or more races are sailed a competitor will be allowed to drop their lowest score.

Awards will be presented within individual fleets, but **THE LOWEST CORRECTED SCORE ACROSS ALL LASER FLEETS WILL BE AWARDED "THE PLANK TROPHY"** (A Perpetual trophy taken from all that is left of our clubhouse after Superstorm Sandy).

VIII. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

a. Sailing instructions will be available at check in.

IX. RISK:

a. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks (See RRS 4 Decision to Race). The decision to enter the regatta, to start or continue any race is up to the competitor. Furthermore, each competitor accepts full responsibility for his/her actions during any activity related to the event, including on-shore activities.
