PARKER ROAD WIDENING

The City of Aurora and the Colorado Department of Transportation are hosting an open house to preview the proposed widening of Parker Road from Belleview Ave to Hampden Ave. The open house is scheduled for Tuesday, October 20 from 6-9 pm at Shalom Park. This plan has been under development and review for several years and will have a definite impact on Andover Glen. The widening will include making the Parker Road / Quincy Ave. intersection an underpass similar to the intersection at Parker Road and Hampden Ave. The proposal also includes the addition of a dedicated acceleration lane from Saratoga onto northbound Parker Rd. and closing the southbound turn lane from Parker Road to Whitaker. The turn lane closure will definitely add more traffic through Andover Glen on both Saratoga and Layton Avenues. Anyone interested in learning more about the project is encouraged to attend.

BE PREPARED

While we have enjoyed an abnormally warm September, we all know that snow and cold weather are just around the corner. The weather “experts” are predicting an active El Nino winter. Take time now to prepare for the challenges the season brings us: get your snow shovels out of storage and placed for easy access; if you are fortunate to have a snow thrower, test the engine to see that it starts easily and make sure you have an ample supply of fuel available; avoid costly water damage to your property by keeping your gutters and downspouts cleared of leaves and debris; check for aged or worn weather stripping and replace as necessary; make sure that you have good tread on your tires, or switch to snow tires for the winter; check your car battery to make sure it has a good charge and that your anti-freeze is good for those cold winter mornings: check that your windshield scraper and brush are in good condition and actually in your car. Please remember that Aurora City Code requires that snow 1 inch or more be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of the storm. If you are away, please arrange for a neighbor or friend to take care of your walks.
