Quilt Show Update

The Yellowknife Quilters' Guild 2019 Quilt show will be held **September 20, 21 and 22nd** at Centre Ice Plaza (Luluz). It has been a couple of years since we last had a show, and our numbers have grown, so I am really looking forward to seeing lots of participation from our members. What I think I love best, and I know we get sneak peeks at Show 'N Tell, is the inspiration from these shows. There is such a variety of quilted items and it gives the public and the "closet" quilters who do not belong to the Guild, a chance look at all the things we create, not just "blankets". **There will be three categories – Quilt, Wall Hanging and Other. Visitors to the show will be able to vote for their top 3 in all categories.**

If space is available, we will also be highlighting the last challenge done by the guild using the "Have a Beautiful Day" fat quarter and a book from the Library as inspiration. Those who participated are asked to bring their pieces in on the Thursday Night as well. We are also hoping to provide sewing space for members who want to drop in and sew. It would be kind of like being at the Raven when we quilt there either on our UFO's or classes and those visiting the store check out what is happening.

We will circulate a copy of the **"label" that should appear on your item**. You can fill it in using Word or write it out by hand (legibly of course), then bring it when you drop off your items on Thursday Night.

We are also doing a **Shop Hop** as part of the show. The general concept of this is, visitors to the show would visit the participating stores, get their card (we will provide) stamped and a draw will be made of all completed cards for a prize. **Kathy Yurris** is coordinating this aspect of the show.

So, long story short, this is an opportunity to showcase everyone's work, large or small. Don't be shy, you are a very talented group of people. Let's make this one of our best shows!

We will need volunteers to help set up on Thursday night, man the show through the 3 days and tear down. Given the location, we will have to have supervision of the show for the same hours Centre Ice Plaza is open. If you can spare a couple of hours, please sign the sheet at the Guild meeting or let me know (lgw@northwestel.net). We will also need accessories to enhance the presentation of our items. Quilt Racks and Ladders, inflatable beds, etc.

Once the poster is ready to go out, we will be using every avenue at our disposal to get the word out. When you see it on FB or Twitter or Instagram..... share, share share. That will cover the social media connection, but I would encourage you to tell your friends, family and coworkers all about it....

Knowledge of paper piecing is not required but recommended. Emphasize your own creativity and feel free to decide if you like to change the color of the bird, delete the ball of yarn as well as the moon or keep both. This is going to be a great wall hanging and is very relevant to life in the north!!! Size approx. 24" x 35" - depending on your design choices

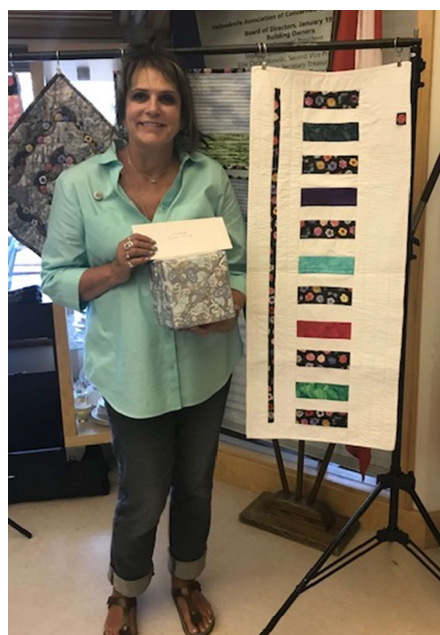

Slow Cooker Lasagna

With the cooler weather at our doorstep, this recipe is easier than the oven version and just as delicious.

Ingredients:

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 1 onion, chopped
- 2 teaspoons minced garlic
- 1 (29 oz.) can tomato sauce
- 1 (6 oz.) can tomato paste
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 (12 oz.) pkg. lasagna noodles
- 12 oz. cottage cheese
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 16 oz. shredded mozzarella cheese

Directions:

1. In a large skillet over medium heat cook the ground beef, onion, and garlic until brown. Add the tomato sauce, tomato paste, salt, and oregano and stir until well incorporated. Cook until heated through.
2. In a large bowl mix together the cottage cheese, grated Parmesan cheese, and shredded mozzarella cheese.
3. Spoon a layer of the meat mixture onto the bottom of the slow cooker. Add a double layer of the uncooked lasagna noodles. Break to fit noodles into slow cooker. Top noodles with a portion of the cheese mixture. Repeat the layering of sauce, noodles, and cheese until all the ingredients are used.
4. Cover, and cook on LOW setting for 4 to 6 hours.
