

The BASS board met **Tuesday** to discuss proposed changes to league rules and bylaws. Here is a summary of what was decided:

- 1. The age limit for women was raised to 45. Previously it was 40.**
- 2. There will be no exceptions made to the age restrictions. Men must at least reach the age of 50 during the calendar year of league play.**
- 3. Men who will reach the age of 50 in the following year (or women who will reach 45) will be allowed to play in the fall league.**
- 4. The BASS board will make all decisions regarding balancing of teams.**
- 5. The BASS board will make all decisions regarding the assignments to teams of players who sign up late.**
- 6. MOST IMPORTANTLY, the drafting process will be different this year. All players will go into a common draft. The A league will then draft to form their teams. Players not selected in this portion of the draft will be subject to the B league draft. Players may indicate on their registration form if they wish to play in the B league, and that request will be honored only if the BASS board believes their talent level is appropriate for the B league.**
- 7. To make the draft system work it will be important for all players to register early. Players who have participated in the league previously but do not register in time for the draft risk not being assigned to a team.**
- 8. The spring organizational dinner is scheduled for Luna's Mexican Restaurant, February 2, at 6:30pm.**
