



In addition, Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor achieved the Drivers' Championship and Team title for the No. 3 Corvette C8.R. In the No. 4 Corvette C8.R, Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner finished third in the final GTLM Drivers points standings.

At the conclusion of November's Sebring race, Oliver Gavin bid farewell to his full-time role with Corvette Racing. Although his replacement was announced shortly afterwards (a Porsche driver no less), he leaves huge shoes to fill in the hearts of Oliver Gavin fans!
