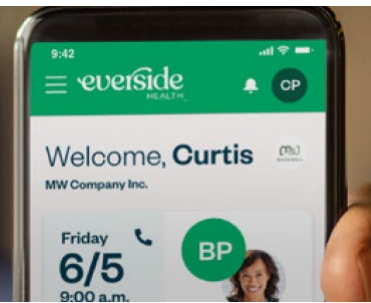
A Message from the Town Administrator

Dear Colleagues,

I wanted to take a moment to thank each of you for your work during our response to COVID-19 and update you on a few things you will notice over the coming weeks. While our response is not over, we are hopeful to see downward trends in COVID-19 as vaccines become widely available. With the expiration of the Town's Emergency Proclamation for Face Coverings, visitors will no longer be required to wear masks in Town facilities. For the time being, staff will continue to be required to wear masks when they are within 6 feet of others and when interacting with the public. Over the next couple weeks, you will see Town Hall and other facilities begin to look like they did prior to COVID-19. Some internal signage and floor/stairway markings will be removed, and lobby furniture will be returned. With these protective measures being phased out as we look to return to normal, it is important to remain vigilant. Please maintain 6 feet distance between yourself and others and wear a mask when you can't. Practice hand hygiene and stay home if you are sick. We have learned much about the resilience of our organization over the past year, and I am grateful for your perseverance and commitment to our community. Thank you. Public Service Matters. - Eric

A Tip From the Risk Management Office

DO YOU KNOW THE 3 SECOND RULE OF DRIVING?



STEP ONE

Pick an object near the road, just ahead of the car in front of you. It can be a tree, building, sign etc.



STEP TWO

Once the car in front of you passes the object, begin counting to 3.
(Use the '1 Mississippi, 2 Mississippi counting technique)



STEP THREE

If you pass the object before you get to 3 Mississippi then you are too close and you need to give the vehicle in front of you more distance.

Not a 'One Size Fits All' rule

- You should always slow down and give vehicles in front of you additional space if conditions are not dry and clear.
- Those who drive an SUV, van or truck should count at least one additional second.
- Drivers of large commercial vehicles should count at least 6 seconds.



What Can I Do Now That I'm Vaccinated?

Activity



- ✓ Inside visits without a mask with other fully vaccinated people.
- ✓ Inside visits without a mask with one household of unvaccinated non-risk people.
- ✓ Travel domestically without a pre- or post-travel test.
- ✓ Travel domestically without quarantining after travel.
- ✓ Travel internationally without a pre-travel test (depending on destination)
- ✓ Travel internationally without quarantining after travel
- ✗ Inside visits, without a mask, with people at increased risk for COVID-19 illness
- ✗ Attend medium or large (non-socially distant) gatherings
