### **OWNERS ONLY WEBSITE**

Have you accessed the **Owners Only** Website?

Did you know you can read; Work Session Notes, approved Board Meeting Minutes, review GHC Financial Statements, read the Strategic Plan and much more...

#### Check in the office for your - Web Access Authorization sign-up Form

Pick up and complete Website Access Authorization Form - and return the form to the office so we have your proper email address and your signed request for access to the private website – on file.

**NEXT**: Press the "Owners Only" button on our existing website page. You will be linked to the private access site. Click "sign up" - if this is your first time.

LAST: Enter the email address you included on your form and create your own password.

Your Request will be verified against your completed / signed form on file.

Now you will be approved to access the Owners Only private section of our website.

#### **SPECTRUM BULK TV SERVICE!!**

Residents at Gulf Harbors are entitled to one free **TV Box**, to watch your television. A **TV Box** is required for each TV, to receive Spectrum TV Channels.

Call Spectrum at **1-855-222-0102** – ASK for their Bulk TV Team. Give the representative **your GHC civic address** as our GHC addresses have been entered into their system to identify you as part of the <u>Bulk TV Service</u> program.

With Our **Bulk TV** service with the TV Box you are entitled to Spectrum Packages of: *Spectrum TV Basic, TV Select and TV Bronze*. (TV Bronze is **Spectrum Digital Tier 1**. It is the Silver package listed on their website, without the Movie channels). Additional TV boxes are an additional cost to you as well as other additional channels, movie channels etc. Your *Internet and Phone rates may change at any time. Exception is our Bulk TV rate on Contract.* 

**Note:** If you are advised that your address is not entered in their bulk TV system, please call our GHC office and advise Cindy. The office will contact Spectrum to ensure the address is then added.



## MAINTENANCE CORNER

Here we go again talking about those wipes that are used for your body and for cleaning. We ask again, **DO NOT FLUSH THEM DOWN THE TOILET.** A toilet is just for human waste and toilet paper, only.
