2019 has been a year of changes! On May 16, 2019, Governor Polis signed HB19-1120 that changed the age of consent to twelve. Sunset Review for the Colorado Mental Health Statute started, and the DORA Report will be published in October 2019 for a new law in 2020. Are you aware of how to best limit your liability to avoid DORA regulatory board complaints and lawsuits in your clinical practice with individuals, couples, children, adolescents, and families?
