



Prospect School Parent/Visitor Code of Conduct

The Governors and Headteacher of Prospect School have a duty of care to safeguard the students and staff that attend its provision.

One of our expectations is that adults set a good example for students at all times in their interactions and behaviour.

The school's premises are private property, and the school may ban parents from entering the site if necessary to safeguard and protect members of the school community.

The following behaviours will not be tolerated

- *Using offensive language*
- *Damaging or destroying school property*
- *Using loud or offensive language, or displaying temper causing staff to feel threatened*
- *Sending abusive or threatening emails or text/voicemail/phone messages, or other written communications to anyone within the school community*
- *Defamatory, offensive or derogatory comments regarding the school or any of the students/parents/staff/governors on Facebook or other sites*
- *Use of physical, verbal or written aggression towards another adult or child, including physical punishment of your own child on school premises*
- *Approaching someone else's child in order to discuss or chastise them because of the actions of this child towards their own child*
- *Using social media to publicly challenge school policies or discuss issues about individual children or members of staff*
- *Bringing the school into disrepute*

Police may be contacted if parents cause a nuisance or disturbance on school premises
