Here are a few facts that you may want to know about our club:

- The club is purely a social club and normally hosts events monthly. These functions are well planned and presented and will normally include dinner, entertainment, special decorations, music and dancing. They are always BYOB and are normally done at either the Performing Arts Center (PAC) or the Lodge.
- The club is run by the officers and board members listed above. We have an annual general meeting in January to elect officers, but other than that, the mission is to have a good time and make friends.
- Each of our events is chaired by volunteer members who plan the music, food and decorations. The co-chairs for an event will each receive one free ticket for the event (limited to one (1) in a 12 month period). We publish a newsletter each month, a copy can be picked up at the Lodge Library or received by email. The newsletter contains reviews of the last event and announcements for future events. - Seating is limited to about 300 at the PAC and 190 at the Lodge, accordingly with 1200 plus members, tickets are usually are sold out in a short time. To attend an upcoming event it is highly recommended that you arrive at the earliest announced ticket sales date. Bring your name tags and a check for the appropriate amount to the Lodge main room on the sales dates.
- A member may purchase up to three (3) tickets for members (maximum of four (4) per household). The four (4) tickets include the spouse or "friend" of the member. Name badges must be presented for all ticket purchases. The name on the badge presented must match the person attending the event. The price of a ticket for friends or guests (non-members) is \$2.00 more than the member price.
