Early Voting: In-person voting at your assigned polling place
Sat, Oct 31 - Sun, Nov 1 - Mon, Nov 2 8am to 5pm

Your neighborhood polling location is listed in the yellow box on back of your Sample Ballot Booklet *Bring your mail-in ballot to surrender. You will be given a paper ballot so you can vote in person at the polls. If you don't surrender the mail ballot, you will be given a provisional ballot to vote. You don't want this.

Early Voting is also available at Registrar of Voters (ROV) office 5600 Overland Ave. SD 92123 Mon thru

Fri: 8 am to 5 pm

Election Day Voting: ROV & Local Polling Locations - Voting Hours: 7am to 8pm

To use your mail ballot...make sure to sign the outside of the envelope before delivering it to either: <u>Local library</u>, <u>Local polling location</u>, or the <u>Registrar of Voters</u>.
