

CALL FOR TLAL ARTISTS ONLY

The Latino Art League of Greater Washington DC (TLAL) invites all TLAL artists residing in Maryland, Washington & Virginia and all TLAL artist members overseas to participate in our first "Members Only Art Show" for artists working in two-and three-dimensional formats. This exhibit is a highlight of the Hispanic-Latino Heritage Celebration which is coordinated by the City of Gaithersburg's Multicultural Affairs Committee.

- Exhibition Dates: From September 4 through October 25, 2015
- Submissions Deadline: Drop off for artwork will be on August 31, 2015, at 10:30am.

Terms of Entry for Silent Auctions

- Exhibition and Presentation Guidelines are detailed in this prospectus. Additional information will be included in the acceptance letter.

Eligibility

- All TLAL members living in Maryland, Washington DC & Virginia and overseas are eligible to enter.

Work

- A maximum of six original works, with no more than six years old will be allowed.
- Works exhibited previously in any TLAL event(s) are also eligible to participate.
- The works must be two-dimensional and cannot exceed 60 inches in height or width.
- The works must be properly framed and professionally presented. They should carry complete information on the upper back: title, size, medium, artist name, price, year of execution, and email.

Entries and Submission Fees

- Artwork must be delivered in person on the day and time mentioned above.
- Participation fee is \$ 20 USD. Participation fees are non-refundable and must be paid to TLAL before the opening of the exhibition.
- The City of Gaithersburg will take a 30% commission on any work sold during the exhibit and for any work sold up to 6 months following the show as a direct result of the exhibit.
- TLAL will not withhold commission for sales on this specific event.
- The images of accepted works may be used for promotional purposes, including but not limited to the invitation, catalog, website and social networks or promotional material by TLAL and / or the city of Gaithersburg and the Arts Council of Montgomery. Image will include attribution whenever possible.
- The works must remain in the gallery throughout the duration of the exhibit.

- The artists will pick up unsold work on Monday, October 26, 2015 at 10 AM.
- The gallery does not have storage facilities for work that has not been collected at the close of the exhibition. Therefore, the City of Gaithersburg and TLAL will not ensure or be liable for any damages or loss to the artwork that is not collected on time.
- A late charge of \$5.00 per day, per piece of art will be levied for work not removed on the designated date.
