Saint Andrew was an Apostle of Jesus and the brother of Saint Peter. He was a fisherman. While not much is said about him in the Gospels, tradition holds that he preached the Good News in what is now Greece and Turkey and was martyred by crucifixion.

Challenge of the Week

There is a tradition to say a Christmas Novena beginning November 30 on St. Andrew's feast. It's a short and simple prayer, so consider saying it together as a family for nine days:

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment
In which the Son of God was born of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in piercing cold. In that hour vouchsafe, O my God! To hear my prayer and grant my desires, through the merits of Our Savior Jesus Christ, and of His blessed Mother. Amen.

A note about Christmas and Holy Family 2021, and Solemnity of Mary 2022

This year, Christmas, December 25th, falls on a Saturday, with the Holy Family on Sunday, December 26th. Here is a handy chart from the Bishop's Committee on Divine Worship to understand what this means for fulfilling the obligation to attend Mass:

Nativity of the Lord (Christmas)	Holy Family
Obligation may be fulfilled from the evening of Friday, December 24 through Saturday, December 25.	Obligation may be fulfilled from the evening of Saturday, December 25 through Sunday, December 26.
For example, one may attend: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Vigil Mass of the Nativity Mass during the Night (celebrated at any time) Morning/afternoon/evening Masses on December 25 	For example, one may attend: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Afternoon/evening Masses on December 25 (even though the Mass texts will be for the Nativity) Morning/afternoon/evening Masses on December 26
