**Facts:** Pltfs., both age 17 at the time, claimed that they were riding a motorbike eastbound on Bochlmer Rd.

on the Town of Deer Park when they were struck head-on by Deft.'s vehicle, which was owned by Deft. Ross and driven by Deft. Schultz, as he crossed the center line. Pltf. Overland was a passenger on the motorbike, which was driven by Swingle. Deft.'s expert testified about the skid marks. The impact occurred at a sharp curve in the road. Deft. Argued that Pltf. was traveling on the wrong side of the highway, resulting in the collision. Photographs showed skid marks of Deft.'s vehicle in the

correct lane at the time of impact.

<u>Injuries</u>: (not before the jury) <u>Swingle</u>: fractures of the left (nondominant)humerus, radius, ulna, left femur, tibia, fibula, ankle, and hip; concussion. Pltf. was hospitalized for one month. <u>Overland</u>: multiple fractures of the left femur, tibia, fibula and ankle. He was also hospitalized for one month. <u>Demonstrative evidence</u>: photographs of the vehicle skid marks. <u>Specials</u>: \$250,000 for Overland.

No offer; demand: \$150,000 for each Pltf. Jury deliberation: 25 minutes. Carrier: USF&G.

Pltf. Expert: There was no expert testimony for Pltf.

Deft. Expert: Richard Hermance, engineer, Tillson.
