

**CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2018-005**

**Being a By-law to amend By-law 2017-009, being a  
By-law to Authorize the Use of Certain Off-road  
Vehicles on Municipal Highways**

**Recitals:**


1. The *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes Ontario's municipalities to establish rules for the use of its highways.
2. Council passed By-law Number 2017-009 on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017, to allow certain off-road vehicles to be used on the Municipality's Highways for a trial period of one year.
3. By-law 2017-009 provides that it is to expire one year from the date of its passage unless it is amended. At its regular meeting of February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018, Council considered this matter and determined that the trial year had been successful and that the expiration date of the by-law should be removed.

**ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Amendment to By-law 2017-009: Section 7 of By-law 2017-009, which reads as follows:  
This By-law shall take effect on the date that it is passed, and will remain in effect for one calendar year, after which time, if it has not been amended to be extended, it will automatically be repealed.  
  
is deleted, and the following wording is substituted:  
  
This By-law shall take effect on the date that it is passed.
2. Balance Confirmed: The balance of By-law 2017-009 is confirmed, as enacted.
3. Effective Date: This By-law shall take effect retroactively as at March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
