
WHEN TO RESEAL YOUR NATIVESTONE®

Like all sealed concrete, NativeStone will eventually need to be resealed. Generally, kitchen sinks and vanity tops should be resealed every 2-3 years; tubs, lavatories and bar prep sinks every 5 years. However, resealing intervals can be impacted by frequency of use, maintenance of the product and other general conditions. Gloss reduction, scratching, chipping, denting, staining, and acid or alkaline etching of the finish over time due to use, cleaning practices or water or atmospheric conditions, are not manufacturing defects but are indicative of normal wear and tear.

You will know it's time to reseat once you start to see water marks appearing in the basin that evaporate once the basin is dry. Think of the dark mark on a concrete sidewalk that appears when wet, then disappears when the sidewalk dries.
