

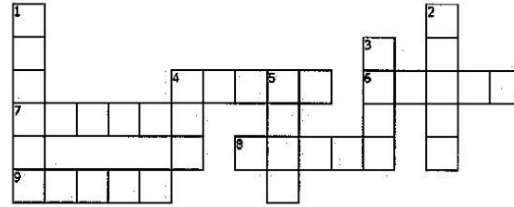

Crossword Puzzle



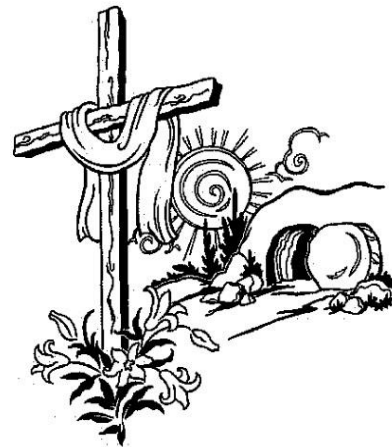

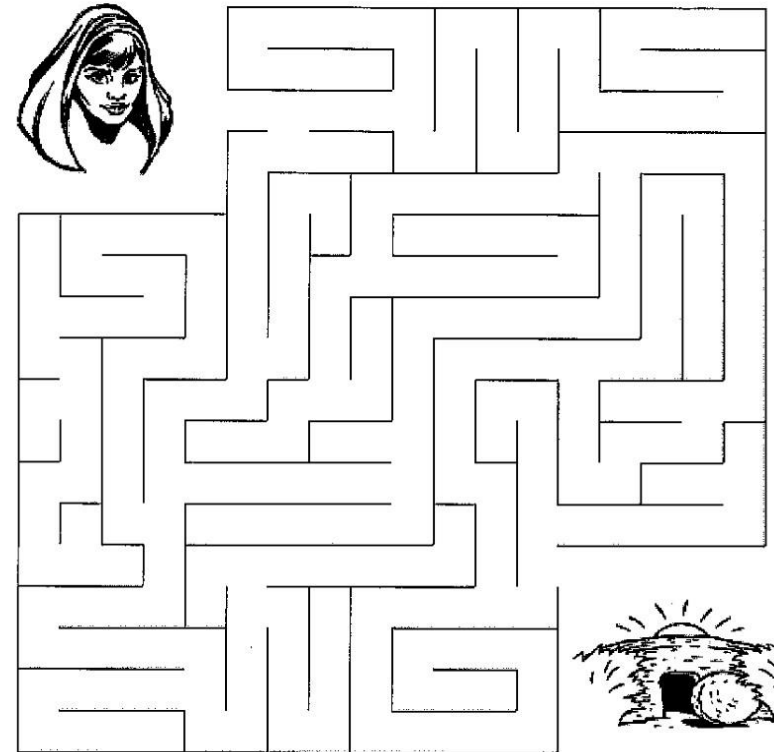
