

St Perpetua & St Felicity – March 7!

St. Perpetua and St. Felicity were both from North Africa. They are the Patron Saints of mothers and **81010** to sign up for remind updates. expectant mothers. Perpetua was a noblewoman and Felicity was enslaved to Perpetua. Perpetua and Felicity were arrested along with two other catechumens (people preparing for Baptism). Both women were mothers, Perpetua had an infant son and Felicity was eight months pregnant. Felicity was able to give birth during her imprisonment and both Saints were baptized while imprisoned. During this time they also converted their prison guards to the faith. The two women refused to deny their Christian faith and were sentenced to die by being thrown to wild animals. They survived and then were executed. Their friendship is a great example to us even today.
