

STUDY GUIDE

- 1) When driving, a motorist must have **insurance**, **permit or license**, **and registration**.
- 2) During daylight hours, when raining, a motorist must have wipers and headlights on.
- 3) A person may operate a moped with a moped license, motorcycle license, and basic license.
- 4) To get a probationary license you must have completed **6 months of supervised** driving, excluding any suspensions or postponements, pass the road test, and be at least **17 years old**.
- 5) Special learner and examination permit restrictions- Passengers must be **parents and up to 1 additional person.**
- 6) GDL Driver exemptions- driver's 21+ years old are exempted from the **hours/time**, **passenger rule**, **and decal rules**.
- 7) The examination permit is different from a student learner permit, because the application does not need an **instructor** to get an examination permit.
- 8) At the time of your road test, you must present a **permit, ID for student, supervisor's** license, registration, insurance, and an inspection sticker.
- 9) If an applicant fails the road test, he/she must wait at least **2 weeks** before taking it again.
- 10) Altering a driver license or showing an altered driver license may result in loss of a motorist's driving privilege, a fine up to \$1000, and/or up to 6 months imprisonment.
- 11) Change of address needs to be reported to MVC within 1 week.
- 12) Change of name needs to be reported to MVC within 2 weeks.
- 13) A new resident of NJ has **60 days** to apply for a NJ license.
- 14) GDL permits are valid for up to 2 years.
- 15) A probationary license is probationary for 1 year.
- 16) Getting a driver's license illegally may result in a fine of **\$200-\$500** and/or imprisonment of **30-90 days**.
- 17) If you violate a GDL restriction you may face a fine of up to \$100.
- 18) Supervising driver must be **21 years old, have 3 years experience, and have a valid NJ license.**

- 19) What are the seven things that need to happen before you can get a Special Learner's Permit?
  - 1. Must be 16
  - 2. Driver's ed course
  - 3. Pass written test
  - 4. Pay fee
  - 5. Instructor buys permit
  - 6. Pass vision test
  - 7. 6 Hours behind the wheel driving program
- 20) )What are 3 things needed in order to get a basic license?
  - 1. Must be at least 18 years old
  - 2. Pay fee
  - 3. 1 Year unsupervised driving
- 21) What are the 6 restrictions?
  - 1. 11:01pm-5:00am
  - 2. No electronics at all
  - 3. All passengers must wear seatbelts
  - 4. Must display red decals
  - 5. Parent/guardian + 1 additional person
  - 6. Supervisor must be 21+ with 3 years of driving experience.
- 22)When can you drive 25 Miles per hour? In residential, business, and school locations.
  - 23)If a vehicle is passing you, you should **slow down and let them pass.**
  - 24)Most passing is done on the **left**.
- 25)Pass on the right, when the person ahead is turning left and there is room on the right.
  - 26)You should always yield to right, pedestrians, and emergency vehicles.
- 27) At a multi-way stop or 4-way intersection, a motorist must yield to the motorist on the **right.**
- 28)When approaching an uncontrolled intersection you must **reduce speed and be ready to stop.** 
  - 29)Acceleration lane- Extra lane used to **enter** a highway.
  - 30) Deceleration lane- Extra lane used to exit a highway.
  - 31)If you miss an exit on the expressway, you should continue and go to the next one.
  - 32) The best way to enter a curve is to reduce speed before entering.
  - 33) When driving around a curve, your vehicle may tend to keep going straight.

- 34) When are you allowed to turn on red? 3 parts:
  - 1.After a motorist comes to a full stop.
  - 2. After checking traffic for those who have right of way
  - 3. Make sure there is no sign for no turns on red.
- 35) Before making a turn, you must signal at least 100 feet in advance.
- 36) Signals should be used when turning, changing lanes, stopping, or merging.
- 37) What do you do if a bus is stopped on the street picking up kids? Stop at least 25 feet away.
- 38) If a school bus has stopped directly in front of a school to pick up or let off children, a motorist may pass from either direction at a speed of no more than 10mph.
- 39) When approaching a railroad crossing with flashing lights, you should STOP.
- 40) What do you do if an emergency vehicle wants to pass you? Pull over to the right as much as possible and stop.
- 41) Headlights must be used 30 minutes before/after sunrise or sunset, bad weather, or unable to see 500 feet ahead.
- 42) When are high beams (bright beams) used? Open country roads/country driving when no other cars are around.
- 43) How far away can you park from a stop sign? 50 feet.
- 44) How far away can you park from a fire hydrant? 10 feet
- 45) Where should baby seats be placed? Back/rear of vehicle.
- 46) What do you do with your left arm if you want to show someone you are making a left? Straight out.
- 47) What do you do with your left arm if you want to show someone you are making a right? Out and up.
- 48) What do you do with your left arm if you want to show someone you are slowing down? Out and down.
- 49) Where should your wheels be turned if you are parking downhill? Toward the curb.
- 50) Where should your wheels be turned if you are parking uphill? Away from the curb.
- 51) Seat Belts help you by
  - 1.Sliding
  - 2. Hitting the dashboard.
  - 3.Being thrown from the vehicle.
- 52) In city driving, it is a good habit to drive slowly, watch out for pedestrians, and apply the 12 second rule.
- 53) If you have a flat tire or blow out you should gradually slow down and pull over.
- 54) When driving at night you should be able to stop within sight distance.
- 55) To avoid driving hypnosis, you should avoid looking at one thing for more than a few seconds.
- 56) If you have a tire blow out
  - 1. Hold steering wheel firmly
  - 2. Let off of the gas
  - 3. Coast to a stop.
- 57) To avoid a skid you should take foot off of the gas.
- 58) The best way to talk to other drivers on the road is to use your horn and lights.
- 59) What is the 3 second rule used for? Following distances.

- 60) After driving through a deep puddle, you should immediately test your brakes by pumping them to dry them off.
- 61) To regain control during a skid, you should turn in the same direction as the rear.
- 62) It is good practice to keep a space cushion (comfort space) or following distance so you have time to react.
- 63) Road surfaces are most slippery the first few minutes after rainfall.
- 64) If your wheels drift onto the dirt shoulder of the road and you want to return to the paved road you should
  - 1. Slow down
  - 2. Regain control
  - 3. Turn slowly back onto the road
- 65) If your brakes suddenly give out what should you do: shift to a lower gear and pump them.
- 66) Accident prevention formula: Be alert, be prepared, and act in time.
- 67) Driving while under the influence of intoxicating beverages means one's sense and judgment is impaired.
- 68) Drugs that may affect basic driving skills are cold pills, tranquilizers, prescription meds.
- 69) If you drink and have reached a BAC of slightly above .05% the risk of you causing a motor vehicle accident doubles.
- 70) The best way to reduce your chances of having an alcohol related accident is to not drink and drive.
- 71) Whether your blood alcohol content rises above legal limits depends on
  - 1. Quantity
  - 2. Quickness
  - 3. Food
  - 4. Weight
- 72) If a person has been drinking, what can sober them up: time.
- 73) Which 3 drinks have the same alcohol content:
  - 1. 1.5 oz liguor
  - 2. 5 oz wine
  - 3. 5 oz beer
- 74) After two to four drinks, alcohol begins to impair your balance, coordination, and reaction time.
- 75) If under 21, NJ law states that you may be under influence if your blood alcohol level content is .01%
- 76) If 21 or older, NJ law states that you may be under the influence if your blood alcohol content is .08%.
- 77) What is the 2nd most often drug found in vehicles involved in collisions? Marijuana
- 78) If a person gets drunk in your home and has a motor vehicle accident after leaving your home, you could receive a lawsuit.
- 79) If you lose your license for drunk driving or any other violations, you cannot drive for any reason until the stated period of time is over.
- 80) When your license is returned to you after suspension for points (or after completing a DMV Driver Improvement Program), you will be on probation for 1 year.

- 81) If you are involved in a motor vehicle accident resulting in injuries while your driving privileges are suspended, you are subject to a fine, continued suspension, possible 45 day jail sentence.
- 82) Under GDL law, a person is required to attend a remedial training class for the following 2 reasons:
  - 1. 4 points
  - 2. DUI
- 83) Which 2 convictions will result in an insurance surcharge?
  - 1. Refuse a breath test.
  - 2. Operating the vehicle while under the influence.
- 84) Implied consent law means you must submit to a breath test given by law enforcement.
- 85) Saying no to a breath test will result in: MVC insurance surcharge, blood alcohol level (BAC) of .10%, and \$1000 per year for 3 years.
- 86) If you want to avoid a drinking and driving accident, arrange for a designated motorist, public transportation, and call a cab.
- 87) In adverse weather conditions, a truck takes 25% longer to stop.
- 88) If being passed by a motorcycle, you should maintain speed and position.
- 89) When sharing the road with large trucks or buses, you should:
  - a. Give more road way when a truck is making a turn.
  - b. Leave more space when stopping behind a truck
  - c. Maintain a constant speed when passing
- 90) If the driver of a large truck or bus cannot see you in his rearview mirrors, you are in their blind spot/no zone.
- 91) What are 3 limitations for trucks?
  - a. Visibility
  - b. Required stopping distance
  - c. Maneuverability
- 92) If you sell your car (and do not buy another), what should you do with the license plates?
  - 1. You should bring the plates back to the mvc.
- 93) Every vehicle in NJ must have liability insurance.
- 94) When you move into this state, you must have your vehicle inspected within 14 days.
- 95)If your driver's license is lost or stolen, you should immediately notify the police.
- 96)A triangular sign is a yield sign.
- 97)A diamond shaped sign is a warning sign.
- 98)The order of the colors on the traffic light, hung top to bottom is Red, Yellow, Green.
- 99) The shape of a stop sign is an Octagon.
- 100)A railroad crossing sign is in a circle shape and black and yellow coloring.
- 101)When are you allowed to drive on public or private property to avoid a sign or signal?
  - 1. Only when the police direct you to.
