The meeting was called to order by the Vice- ATTENDANCE Chairman, Gary Wilson at the District Office at $7:00\,$ A.M. Other Grand County Water Conservancy District members present was John Groo.

Grand County Special Service District members present were Gary Wilson, George White, Bill McDougald and Dan Holyoak.

Others present were Ferne Mullen, County Commissioner, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of January MINUTES 17, 1989. After calling for additions or corrections and hearing none, the Chair declared the minutes approved as read.

Dale reported that House Bill 213 referred to in $_{
m HB}$ $_{
m 213}$ the memo to the Board has a lot of holes and that Water Conservancy Districts have many concerns about the bill, and the 10 year sunsetting raises many concerns in the financial community. Bond life is extremely important to water and sewer projects, and the Board discussed problems other Districts have with the bill. He reported that there was a meeting in Salt Lake this morning, that Brent Rose would attend on our, and other districts he reperesents' interests, and will report this afternoon.

The bond reorganization meeting Friday with BOND RESummers and community leaders was briefly discussed, and ORGANIZATIONDale pointed out we still have no feel as to what savings GCSSWD will be realized, and that when the data has been gathered, and a figure is released, the Board then can make a decision as to re-writing the bonds.

The irrigation sales report was handed to those IRRIGATION present, and Dale reported this is the best year for SALES REPORT collection ever.

Dale reported he had talked with Barry Saunders, CLOUD SEEDING and the costs for cloud seeding are outrageous. A fixed COSTS cost of \$18,000 to set up and approximately \$5,000 for the generators, is required and since all funding has been allocated, the District would have to pay all of the costs. The County has indicated no interest. Dan moved the Diswithdraw from any cloud seeding program. McDougald suggested we keep in touch with the committee next year. The Board agreed by consensus to pursue the matter next year.

David Adkison's proposal to do the 1988/was read AUDIT PROPOSAL to those present. George moved to accept Adkison's proposal. Dan seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

pat Jones' proposal was read, indicating that she KEN'S LAKE would continue the clean up at Ken's Lake for \$350.00 per CLEAN-UP year. The Board agreed by consensus to extend her contract.

Dale reported that Pete Byrd's well would not be BYRD WELL available, and other wells in the lower valley was briefly discussed.

Dale reported the total bill, excluding the work BILL FOR the County did, was \$40,502.00 for reservoir repairs. It REPAIRS TO was suggested a letter of appreciation be sent to the County RESERVOIR for their cooperation in the reservoir repairs.

The meeting adjourned at 8:03 A.M.
