POLICY ON CHARGES AND REMISSION OF CHARGES FOR SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The governing body of Rothesay Nursery School adopted this policy on 12 May 2016 and will review it in May 2017.

Introduction

The governing body is required by Section 110 of the Education Reform Act 1988 to determine policies for (i) making charges for school activities which are permitted by Section 109 of the Act and (ii) remitting such charges.

Charging Policy

Section 106 of the Act confirms the principle that education provided by any maintained school for its registered pupils should be free of charge if it takes place during school hours.

The Governing Body of this school state that all educational activities will take place during school hours. Therefore all will be free of charge.

Voluntary Contributions

The existence of policies on charging and remission of charges does not prohibit voluntary contributions being sought for the benefit of any school activity.

In making a request or invitation for voluntary contributions it must be made clear that there is no obligation to contribute and that registered pupils at the school will not be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution.

The Governing Body request that parents make voluntary contributions to the School Fund on a regular basis towards extra activities.
