Armbands with embedded RFID chips instantly capture information such as:

- › Continuous electronic headcount
- › Instant readout of a missing student
- › Instant access to student photos
- › Access to school medical records

Radio Frequency Identification (RFID), developed during WWII, is a system used successfully to tag and identify all types of "stuff"—from tiny instruments to living organisms.

RFID utilizes small tags embedded with antenna that are attached to the tracked item. When a reader within range sends signals, the associated RFID chip responds with the identification code embedded in the tag, and relates to a back office database where the information is stored.

RFID UTILIZES SMALL TAGS EMBEDDED WITH ANTENNA THAT ARE ATTACHED TO THE TRACKED ITEM. WHEN A READER WITHIN RANGE SENDS SIGNALS, THE ASSOCIATED RFID CHIP RESPONDS WITH THE IDENTIFICATION CODE EMBEDDED IN THE TAG, AND RELATES TO A BACK OFFICE DATABASE WHERE THE INFORMATION IS STORED.



In contrast to bar coding, RFID requires no line of sight with the reader and identifies large volumes of tracked items immediately. RFID is an accepted best practice of international retailers and manufacturers.
