The operator of the shooting range shall maintain any licences or permits to operate issued to it by the province, municipality, township, local government or other organization in relation to operating a shooting range. If any such licence or permit is suspended, revoked or otherwise no longer valid, the shooting range must advise the Chief Firearms Officer immediately.

The operator of the shooting range shall notify, in writing, the Chief Firearms Officer of any changes to the range's executives within 30 days of the change. The following information of new range executive must be provided: His or her name, address, telephone number, and firearms licence number or, if one does not exist, his or her date of birth.

The operator of the shooting range shall ensure that only the approved shooting activities, as noted in this range approval, are conducted in the range facility by all users and that they comply with the limitations as noted in this range approval.

Any changes to the existing operating conditions that this approval has been based upon shall be made in writing to the Chief Firearms Officer. This includes changes in the hours of operation and the range safety rules. The changes can not take effect without the approval of the Chief Firearms Officer.

The operator of a shooting range shall provide written notification to the Chief Firearms Officer within 30 days of any change in the terms of any land-use or easement agreements upon which this approval was based.

The operator of a shooting range shall ensure continued compliance with regards to safety standards, requirement for users, safety training, insurance, and reporting requirements of the Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations.

On or before August 31, 2023 and in accordance with Section 9 of the Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations, the operator of the shooting range shall submit up-to-date copies of the documents set out in paragraphs 3(2)(a) to (c), as well as evidence of continuing compliance with the requirements referred to in paragraphs 3(2)(d) to (g) and sections 5 and 8, to the Chief Firearms Officer.

The range will be inspected at the discretion of the Chief Firearms Officer to ensure the range continues to meet public safety requirements and continued compliance with requirements referred to in the Shooting Club and Shooting Range Regulations.
