The meet will start at 9:00 am

ENTRY FEE: \$6.00 per event, \$24 .00 per relay team. On line entry through Athletic.net at the www.lakeerie.org web site., is the only method used for entries. Instructions will be on the web site. In addition to entering on line, please also bring a waiver signed for under 18 athletes. Clubs please bring your roster club form. **Entry deadline is Friday June 23rd at 9:00pm**

REGISTRATION: Proof of Birth is required. All athletes must be a member of USATF, prior to the meet on line. Relay teams must be registered USATF clubs (2017) also prior to the meet. Club forms available on line at USATF.org or from JoAnn Kitchen. **No day of meet registration.**

Age group 17-18 athletes who are still 18 through the final day of the USATF National Junior Olympic T&F Championships are eligible to compete in the 17-18 age division through that meet....July 24th through July 30th, 2017.

LAKE ERIE ASSOCIATION COUNTIES: Athletes must live in one of these counties: Ashland, Ashtabula, Carroll, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Erie, Geauga, Harrison, Holmes, Huron, Jefferson, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Richland, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, Tuscarawas, Wayne.

PLEASE NOTE: ¼” Spikes permitted. Throwing implements will not be provided.

There is a limit of three (3) events for the 8 and under,(athlete must be 7 years of age on December 31 of the current year to compete) 9-10 and 11-12 age groups. There is a limit of four (4) events for the remaining age groups (13-14 , 15-16, 17-18) The top six (6) in each event including relays will advance to the Region V Championship meet at Cedarville University , Cedarville, Ohio. July 6th to the 9th. The top 5 finishers and top 5 relay teams shall advance to the National Meet from the Regionals to Rock Chalk Park, Lawrence KS on July 24-30. In the combined events, the top two placed individuals and any others who meet the performance standards at the Regional Championships, will advance to the Nationals.

All entries starting with the Association Meet and including the Regional and National must be done on line through ATHLETIC.NET This is the only method used for entries.
