

# Bloomer Baptist Church To Know Christ and Make Him Known

## Pastor's Portion

We are living in an angry moment of history. To be sure there has been angry confrontation many times in American history. Alexander Hamilton and Aaron Burr disagree and dual it out. Abraham Lincoln on his victory tour in 1860 has to skip Baltimore for fear of assassination. Recently a Representative for the US Congress slams a reporter to the ground and punches him. We thought we were living in a civilized society and we find we are as frustrated and are angrier than ever.

How is a Christian to react? That is the point of this Pastor's Portion.

90% of America think there is a serious problem with uncivilized behavior in the public square. How can we expect kids in school to "just get along" when adults and leaders are themselves so childish. Now I have no dream that I can change the political climate of America. But I would like to address this idea of being "KIND TO ALL KINDS."

Under the Inspiration of the Holy Spirit Paul writes to a young pastor about folks in his church in Titus 3:1–2 (ESV): Remind them ...² to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people

Three Points on being KIND TO ALL KINDS from this text and the verses that follow.

- **1. IT IS COMMANDED:** It is not an option. Paul REMINDS us to do this. The reason we have any reminder in Scripture is because we often forget the really important things in the heat of the moment. Paul uses strong words here to avoid quarreling, be gentle and show courtesy toward ALL people not just of our faith tradition or political persuasion.
  - 2. REASONS TO OBEY: Paul lays out 2 reasons:
- A. Because we were once foolish ourselves. Titus 3:3 (ESV) For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another. The idea is we have been delivered! That is our old way of life. 2 Cor 5:17 says we are a new creation in Christ, the old has passed away; behold the new has come.
- B. Because God has been kind to us. Titus 3:4-7 says: But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, <sup>5</sup> he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. The BIG idea is given in vs 5 "He saved us!" This shows the goodness and kindness of God. You and I have been so marvelously blessed with salvation how can we NOT be kind to others.
- **3.** IT IS AN EXCELLENT THING TO DO: Titus 3:8 (ESV): The saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed in God may be careful to devote themselves to good works. These things are excellent and profitable for people. This last verse insists on our being civil to one another. Paul brings home the truth one more time. It is for ALL PEOPLE. Be KIND TO ALL KINDS.
