

Winter 2017 Futsal Tournament – Dec. 17th

5v5 Indoor Soccer - OPEN

All teams participating in the Tournament must abide by the Fair Play Code:

- Play for the fun of it and the love of soccer & be generous when you win; be graceful when you lose.
- Obey the Laws of the Game and accept all decisions made by the officials.

Registration/Rules/Game Times and tournament format:

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to first game to receive a copy of your roster.
- The tournament will be 5v5 (futsal style rules) but two 13 minutes in each game.
- 2 minute half-time break / unlimited substitutions.
- In this tournament, each team will play at least 3 game, two top teams will go to final.
- The top 2 teams will be our finalist and will be awarded prizes.
- A team may have a minimum of 6 players and a maximum of 10 players.
- The Referee is in charge of the game. All referee's decisions are final.
- Any abuse towards a referee will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the tournament.
- Registration fee for an individual player / each day to play in our tournament is \$35
- Registration fee for a team / each day to play in our tournament is \$160.00
- We might try to offer the same style tournament in the 2nd date (Dec. 23rd) if there are enough teams.

Points will be awarded as follows: Win = 3 points / Draw = 1 point / Loss = 0 point

Player Conduct: The following misconducts result in an accumulative foul and a direct free kick for the opposing team: Pushing, Tripping, Obstructing opponents, Slide Tackling, Kicking or Elbowing.

General Rules: No throw-ins, only kick ins - No off sides - Ball is out of play when the whole ball crosses the touch line - Defending team must be 5 yards away from the ball on all kick-ins, corners and free-kicks - If the ball hits the ceiling, play is restarted as a kick in against the team who last touched the ball. Yellow cards will be given out at the referee's discretion. If any player is given 2 Yellow cards in one game, it will result in a Red Card and the player is subsequently expelled for the remainder of the game + (2 minute power-play). If a player is given a straight Red Card, he is expelled from the game and may be subject to further ban at the tournament. Our futsal tournament has a zero tolerance policy when it comes to fighting, abusive language, or abusive behavior.
