

Eddy, Charles

Charles A. Eddy, 79, of Gladwin, passed away Feb. 9, 2003 at the Saginaw Veterans Administration Hospital in Saginaw. He was born May 24, 1923 to Alfred and Helen (Bedford) Eddy in Huron County. Charles was married to Donna Deacons of Fillion in 1946. She preceded him in death in 1986. He married Shirley (Kimmel) Eddy on Sept. 7, 1993 in Blanchard. He was the owner and operator of Eddy Auto Electric, retiring in 1977. He then worked at Brown Machine in Beaverton, retiring in 1984. Charles was a World War II veteran, having served in the United States Army. He has been a resident of Gladwin County since 1967, previously residing in Vassar. He was a member of V.F.W. Post 7303 and God's Love For Humanity in Reed City.
