Rule Proposals

1st Time Submitted

Go back to the point system, instead of money won allowing ropers to get points, that don't money that support the MRA using 6-4 base. 6 points for first, down to 1 at 6th. Over 75 teams the points would double, and over a 100 teams points would triple. This would greatly increase the opportunity for more members to compete at the finals.

Contractors have the same divisions and types of ropings set by the MRA/contractors.

Two secretaries from each contractor are given a free voting and competing membership.

No \$1.00 day permit for any calf roping event. Day permits should be the same as the team roping.

Contractors can offer any calf roping division, or just breakaway (to include youth) as long as it's posted according to MRA rule book.

Electric timers can be used in calf roping events.

Breakaway roping instead of bell collar catch. Makes it any catch as long the loop passes over the head of the animal and the rope is pulled from the saddle horn by animal.

Non-member can only rope in Open.

New Members Names must be emailed/texted into office within 2 days after roping so it can be forward for next roping.

Can only be in Novice for max of 2 yrs regardless of number rating

If Draw Pot Roping it must be computer drawn, printed & posted.

Ropings cannot be capped.

Directors should be at a minimum of 1 out of every 4 ropings or be removed from board. The reason for directors is to make association better and number ropers. Cannot do that if not going.

Number of directors should not be more than 15. No minimum number. No reason to have directors that do not go or not committed to association

2nd Time Submitted

Breakaway: To qualify for finals in breakaway the lady or youth contestant must compete in at least 1 MRA breakaway during the current year. Contestant must compete in at least 4 MRA ropings (breakaway roping or team roping) to qualify for finals/awards.

Breakaway: A legal catch will be considered any catch that passes over the calves nose and pulls the rope and breakaway flag from the contestants saddle horn. If it does not pass over the nose, or fails to pull from the horn it will be a no time.
