1. The President has appointed you, this date, a second lieutenant in the Air Corps of the Regular Army, with rank from January 19, 1943. Your serial number is 025618.

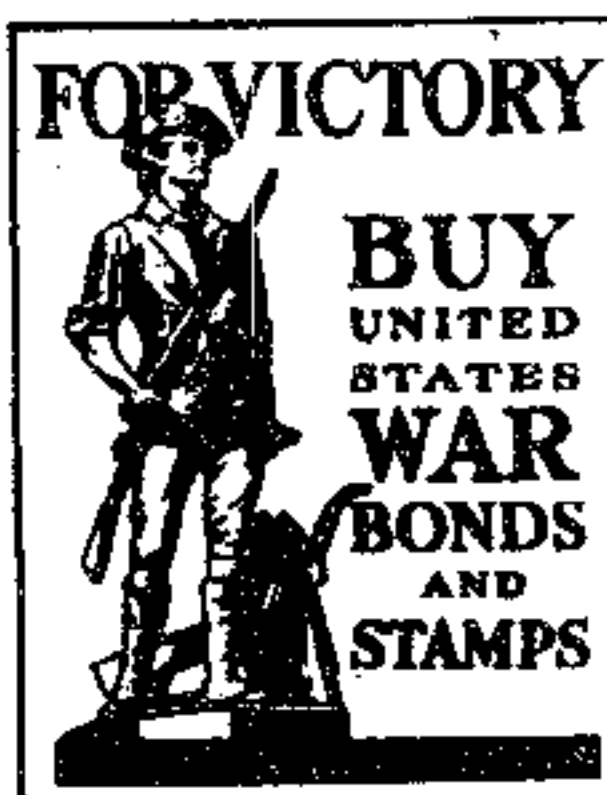
