

Lifting of Fire Ban in Neebing - May 31, 2018

Rainfall in Neebing over the past 48 hours in conjunction with a multi-day weather forecast calling for lower temperatures, higher humidity and additional rainfall, have reduced the wild fire start risk sufficiently to remove the ban on open air fires in Neebing. The ban will be lifted as of noon today and existing permits will be valid once again and new permits will be issued.

Residents are reminded that;

- Rainfall totals for May 2018 remain low at only 20% of 2017 levels.
- The potential to return to high fire hazard conditions is possible.
- No open fires may be started before 2 hours before sunset and all fires must be extinguished by 2 hours after sunrise.
