Success: the infinite power of one partnered with the effectiveness of a well-run Organization

Recent articles published in the local newspaper reported that unaccompanied migrant girls aged 13-17 were being housed in a shelter located in Lake Worth. The infinite power of one partnered with the effectiveness of a well-run organization provided the impetus for Suzy Isaacson, a relatively new member of NCJW, to spearhead a much needed effort to support these children.

Currently 37 girls are staying in the nursing home converted into a migrant shelter. Fifty more girls are expected to arrive shortly. The average time the teens will spend in the shelter is 15 to 30 days with a maximum of two months. The girls will eventually get a sponsor or be united with a family member already living in the U.S. They come from Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras and Nicaragua and some were transported from the Homestead facility.

While there, the teens need many personal items, but heading the list were paper goods, cereal, pajamas, bed sheets, soap, shampoo, snacks, and other supplies that the shelter's budget did not provide for. Suzy Isaacson, a former educational administrator stepped up to the plate and proposed a collection drive to the SE Atlantic section and we decisively said: "Yes!" and immediate plans were made to effect this collection for the shelter's residents.

As with all plans, logistics and geography came into play and, after an e-mail blast describing the charitable project and asking for donations, we received funds that covered the most immediate needs. Suzy Isaacson said: "Hineini - Here I am!" and devotedly volunteered to budget, shop, pre-set loading dock requirements, organize drivers, troubleshoot, and head the distribution of the items that she had identified and purchased.

On Friday, August, 16, 2019 it all came together. The women of the NCJW met at Costco, packed their cars and delivered the list of needed items to the shelter's receiving facility, the Youth Co-Op. While the shelter did not allow any of the women to meet or speak with the residents for security purposes, each member of this task force was heartened by realizing that a great need was met and a mitzvah was well done.

When we feel that as individuals we are limited by our lone, finite abilities. This project reminds us that an identified need, a lucid proposal, an organization devoted to effecting change for good, and the power of one is mightier than ever. Congratulations to Suzy Isaacson, drivers Linda Zaret, Rosaly Almborg, Sue Spector, Beverly Feurring, and Gail Shapiro Scott and all the members who gave generously to this project.

More girls who have few possessions and are far from home are arriving at the shelter. Some of their basic needs are covered by government funding and non-profit support, but not all. At our Opening Brunch on September 18, we will be collecting items such as toiletries, clothing for teenagers (mostly small sizes), twin-sized sheets, Spanish language books, cereal bowls, hard plastic cutlery, towels, and snacks.
