- Must have two letters of recommendations from individuals not related to the applicant
- Must demonstrate volunteerism through participation in community service and activities
- Must demonstrate participation in athletics or club activities (inside or outside school)

TERMS

\$1,000 scholarships will be available for a female and male high school senior who resides in Jackson, Manhattan or Wilton Township. The recipient is advised to be available for the award presentation at the festival on March 4th (parade 11am, ceremony 3pm). The scholarship will be paid to the college or university of the winner's choice.
