



"This Little Light of Mine, I'm Gonna Let it Shine. . ."

Those words from the popular children's gospel song illustrate the life of one of our beloved co-workers who passed away one year ago at Bethany House on March 7th – Carol Mills. Carol let her light shine to all she encountered - hospital visitors, patients, co-workers - and later, when she underwent cancer treatments – the staff in the Cancer Center.

Carol, who was 61, had worked in Quality Management and had been fighting a very rare form of cancer called leiomyosarcoma, a disease she was diagnosed with in 2006. Throughout her illness, she remained positive and was a source of encouragement to many people.

She worked with Dr. Jake Meadows for 17 years, and began working with EAMC in 1989. She continued to work at the hospital at least part-time through January 2010, when she finally had to stop due to her health. During her 20year career at EAMC, she worked on 4SW (Med-Surg) in many roles including floor nurse, assistant unit manager, PCC and clinical coordinator. She later worked in Performance Improvement before moving to Quality Management.

Away from work, Carol was involved in her church, First Baptist of Opelika, where she sang in the choir and taught Sunday school. One of her greatest experiences was traveling with a group to the Holy Land on a trip organized by her church in December 2008.

Her director, Laura Bell (now Assistant Vice President/Quality Management) said of Carol: "Her smile radiated and her laughter echoed throughout the hospital. Those who were privileged to know Carol witnessed the overwhelming love of Jesus in her words and actions, for she truly led a Christ-centered life. Cancer was a vehicle for Carol to spread the word of God, to turn the negative into positive, and to persevere through pain and suffering to perform selfless acts of kindness. Carol was a


teacher, a mentor, a counselor, a friend and a patient advocate. She held uncompromising standards as she served was a gallant fighter and even in the face of death, the patients of East Alabama Medical Center for over 20 years. She her effervescence for loving, laughing, singing, and living was an awesome and amazing wonder to witness. Though we will miss her greatly, those who knew her will never forget the inspiring way she lived her life, the special moments shared together, the wisdom and counsel she freely gave, and the unconditional love she showered on us all. Heaven has now received a treasure—our angel on earth."

Carol's friends and family would like to place a stained glass window in the EAMC Chapel in memory of Carol, so her light can continue to shine for others.
