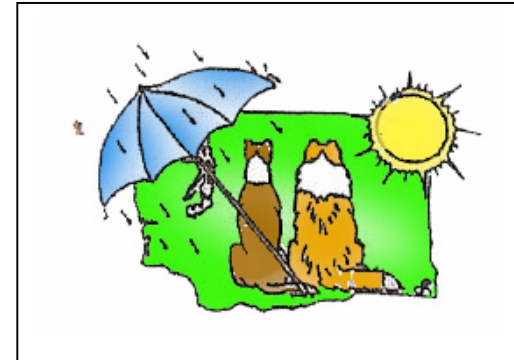

**RING INFORMATION**

Rings (2): 85 wide x 100 deep, indoors on packed dirt.

**ENTRY INFORMATION**

Each Run ..... \$5.00

Dogs may be entered once in STD and once in JWW

One entry form per dog may be used for all days.

**MAKE CHECK PAYABLE (in US Funds) TO: Collie Club of Washington**

**Closing:** Closes Saturday, Oct. 7th, 2017 at 2:00 pm. Entries limited to 100 runs. Method of entry is "First Received"

**Catalog:** \$10.00 – please pre-order catalogs using the entry form. There will be a limited number available the day of the trial.

**Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:**

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

LIMITED ENTRY – send in your entry early as we are limited to 100 runs for this event. Method of entry is "First Received".

A refund of the entry fee, less the judging fee per day will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

**Walk-through & Warm-up**

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 26" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

**CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES**

**Classes Offered**

All levels of Standard STD and JWW, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Match Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

**Preferred Class Information**

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

**AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION**

**Awards**

There are no ribbons awarded at the A Match. Scores awarded at sanctioned A Matches do not count towards title requirements.

An A Match is a prerequisite for a club to hold AKC all breed agility trials in the future. Its purpose is to demonstrate the club's ability to successfully organize and execute all aspects of an all-breed agility trial. As such:

Dogs entered must meet all criteria for entry into an AKC agility trial

No food or toys are allowed in the ring

A dog may be entered in one run of Standard and one run of Jumpers w/Weaves only

A dog must be entered in either the Regular or Preferred track for this event and in the same jump height for both run.

A dog need not be entered in the Overtake Collie Club trial to participate in this event

A dog entered in the Overtake Collie Club trial at competition jump height or Regular/Preferred track may be entered in the A Match at a different height or Regular/Preferred track.

**OBSTACLES AND EQUIPMENT**

**Obstacles**

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Rubberized contacts and weave poles with 24" spacing will be used at this trial.

## ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

### Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all **regular classes**:

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all **international classes (if offered)**:

### Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, please make sure to check the box if your dog needs to be measured.

**Volunteers** are the key to a successful trial and are greatly appreciated. You receive a great free lunch each day you work. We will ensure that your volunteer duties will not interfere with your runs. We will be using the white board system for volunteers. Please sign up to work when you can.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Match Secretary will email exhibitors that she has received their entry if they are in hand by September 26th. After that please confirm with the Match Secretary at the site after noon on the day of the match.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs, or bitches in season. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Collie Club of Washington assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Collie Club of Washington. may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

### Ring & Crating Information

There is plenty of crating at this site. All crating is on concrete, around the periphery of the rings. Please do not block exits/entrances, and do not crate on any elevated platform you may find around the rings

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form.
