“Community grants up for grabs”

Voluntary, charitable and community groups in Bromsgrove District can bid now for grants of up to £500 for local projects.

The latest round of the Small Grants Scheme from Bromsgrove District Council, in partnership with the Bromsgrove Engagement and Equalities Forum, makes grants available for activities that address community issues and support wider community involvement and equality.

Two rounds of the grants will be available over the year, and the deadline for applications to this first round is 4pm on Friday 31st March. Bids in this round must be for projects to be delivered between 1st May and 31st October this year.
